Can they write a story themselves? Perhaps one of their characters might appear! Can you talk with your child about money? Give them coins to look at. Can they notice anything on the coins? Playing shops with your child is a great way for them to learn how to use money. You can add challenge by giving them amount to add together, take away, share out or even double.
