†SAINTS/FEASTS OF THE WEEK†

May 30-St. Joan of Arc-The Patron Saint of soldiers, St. Joan of Arc is considered to be a heroine of France for leading the French troops against England during the Hundred Years War and recapturing the cities of Orleans and Troyes. After a politically motivated trial, St. Joan of Arc was burned at the stake as a heretic in 1431 at the age of 19.

May 31-The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary-Feast day in which immediately after the Annunciation, Mary, while pregnant with Jesus, visited her cousin Elizabeth, who herself was pregnant with John the Baptist.

June 1-St. Justin-An early Christian apologist, St. Justin the Martyr is considered to be the 2nd century's foremost interpreter of the theory of Logos, or the law of generation in the universe.

June 2-Sts. Marcellinus and Peter-Two highly venerated Christian martyrs from the City of Rome, not much is known about Sts. Marcellinus and Peter, who suffered under Diocletian persecution and were imprisoned for their Christian faith.

27 de mayo de 2018 • Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad

El hecho de que seamos en verdad hijos de Dios cambia todo en la historia de la humanidad. Es fascinante estudiar las mitologías antiguas, con tantos dioses, semidioses, monstruos y otras criaturas. Pero en ningún lugar en esas historias hay un simple mortal que proclame la íntima bondad de Dios quien es el padre de toda la unidad, con un amor tierno e inmutable. El libro del Deuteronomio considera esta situación de Dios preguntando: “¿ha pasado algo tan extraordinario alguna vez? ¿Se escuchó algo tan asombroso antes?” El pueblo de Dios debe responder: “¡No, nunca!” Dios, el único y verdadero Dios, ha transformado toda la historia humana al elegirnos como sus amados hijos. Y aunque hemos roto todas las promesas que hemos hecho, Dios ha permanecido fiel a nuestro pacto. Dios nos muestra cómo mantener la fe unos con otros con amor profundo y permanente.

Muchos de nosotros tenemos heridas marcadas por experimentar la infidelidad y el egoísmo. Como pueblo, no tenemos la consistencia de ser buenos para amarnos unos con otros de la misma manera que Dios nos ama. Cada uno de nosotros sabe el dolor salvaje de la indiferencia o la traición. Mucho de nosotros de alguna manera ha lastimado o herido

a otras personas. Aun así, Dios nos ama. La fidelidad de Dios nos anima a intentar nuevamente a amar desinteresadamente.

SALVACIÓN CONTINÚA

Dios se alegra cuando nos refrescamos con el amor de Dios y volvemos a dedicar nuestras vidas a la santidad. Hechos pedazos como estamos, el Señor quiere nuestra ayuda para salvar al mundo. Jesús salvó al mundo una vez y para todos, desde luego, por medio de su cruz y resurrección. Pero el trabajo de la creación de salvación de Dios continúa como Dios provee la gracia a cada persona para trabajar relaciones saludables con Dios y con los demás. Este es un trabajo que continuará hasta el final de los tiempos, y el Señor quiere nuestra ayuda. Esto es lo que significa ser un discípulo de Jesús en la Nueva Evangelización: Debemos pedir la gracia de vida de Jesús, refrescando a otros con su amor.

THE RESPONSIBILITY OF OUR FAITH

Saint Paul reminds us that, because we received the Spirit of adoption in baptism, we are now children of God. In the Gospel Jesus charges us with the responsibility to make other disciples. These realities make today's solemnity a day of praise, adoration, and responsibility. It is a fitting day to thank God for the absolutely free gift of faith that we were given in baptism. 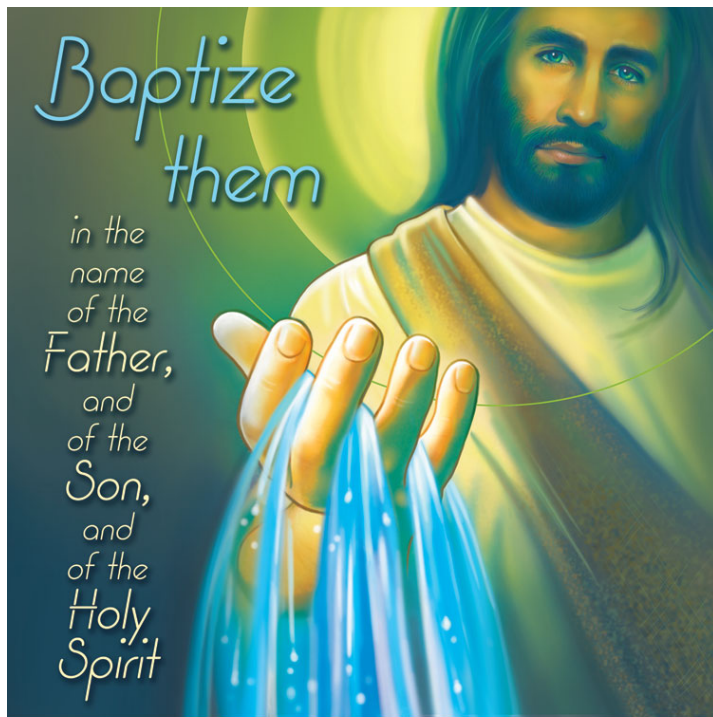

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

One of the great treasures of the Eastern tradition is the icon of the Holy Trinity created by the Russian iconographer Andrei Rublev in the 1400s. The Trinity is symbolized by the three travelers to the tent of Abraham and Sarah. They are seated at a table blessing a cup of wine, under the oak of Mamre. If you look closely, you will see a sacrificed calf in the chalice, reminding the viewer of the cross. The table, prepared for eating and tilted toward the viewer, is an invitation to the Eucharist. From left to right, each figure is keyed to a person of the Trinity. Like all icons, this image is theology in art. The persons are equal in proportion and dignity, they all carry staffs to symbolize their power, and are shown with golden wings and halos. Today, the best place to see Rublev's work is the Holy Trinity Cathedral, at the heart of the vast Holy Trinity monastery about an hour from Moscow. After decades of persecution, it is now once again a living monastery, a world heritage site, and the spiritual home of Russian Orthodoxy. A Google visit is highly recommended today!

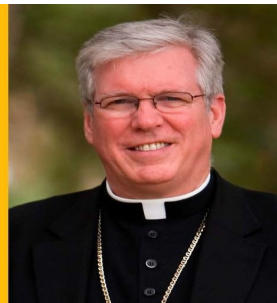
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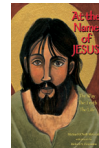


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
