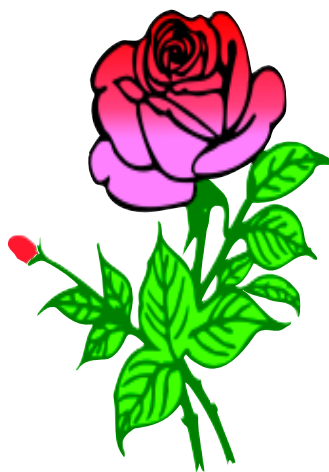
Hey there!

Welcome to the world of Menea!

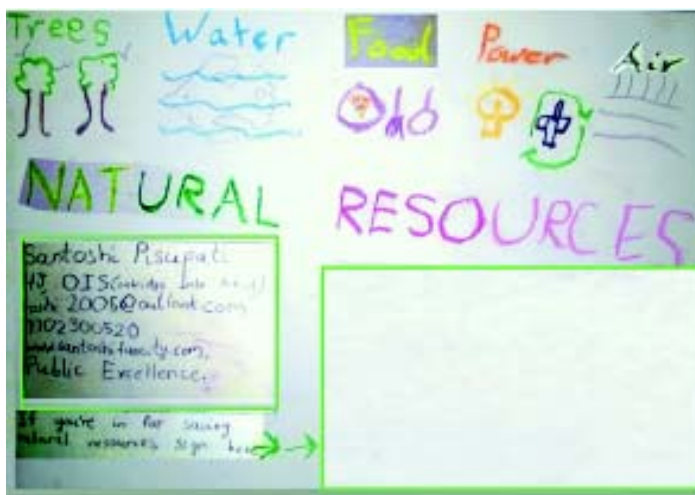
I am Santoshi Pisupati, the author, illustrator and the tour guide for this book.

Save Water!

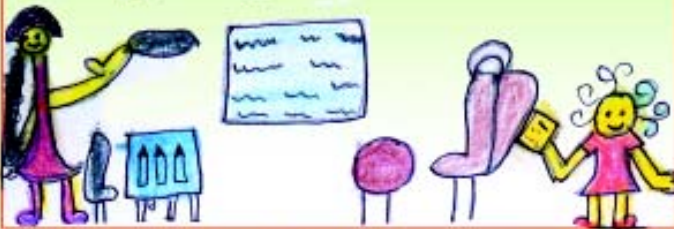
It was a usual day at WVIS,

But Menea kept on playing.



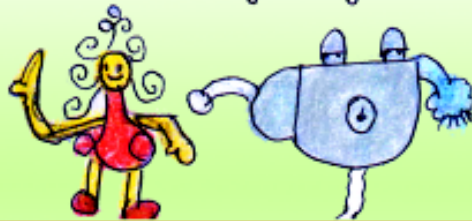
One day, Ms. Tisdale was teaching them about water, again.

One recess, everyone was told to go to wash their hands before playing.



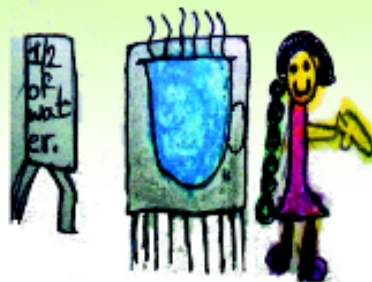
Menea left the tap on and then went to play.

After recess, it was cooking. The menu said: "1/2 of water"



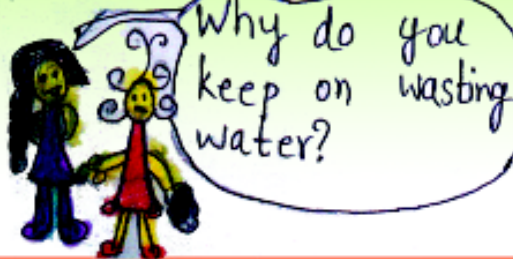
Menea poured 1/2 of water into the pot then she dumped some on the floor.

Save Food

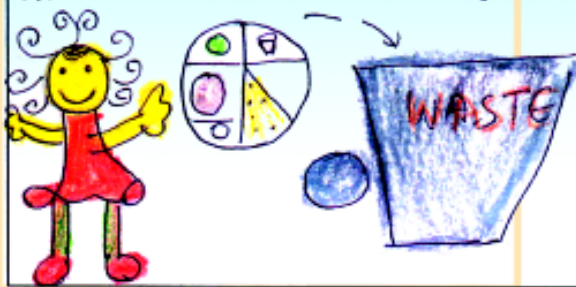
Once upon a time, there was a girl named Menea.



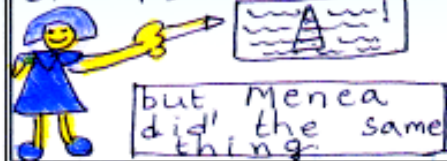
There was also another girl called Isha.

One day, Isha decided to tell Menea what she was doing wrong, but she didn't care.



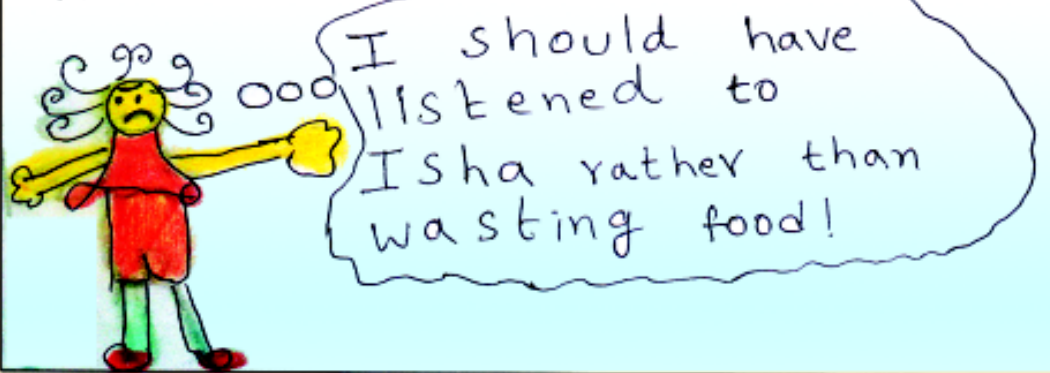
The next day, Ms. Tisdale was not very happy with Menea, so she cancelled her recess for a month.

At school, they were changing jobs.



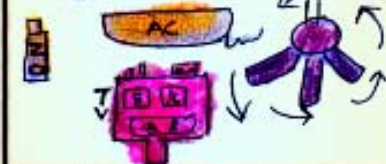
Menea became the power monitor.

She was being lazy and wasting power all the time.



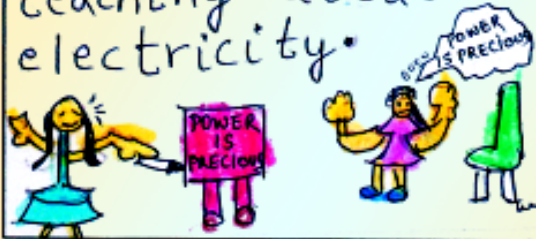
Then, she started damaging power.

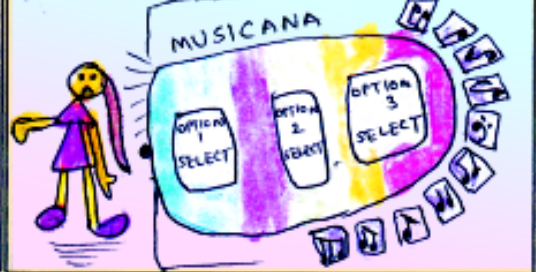

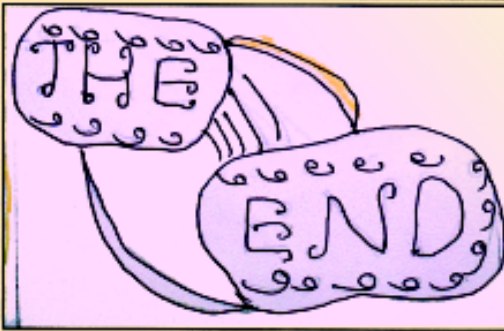

When she came home, she told her mom about her leg.



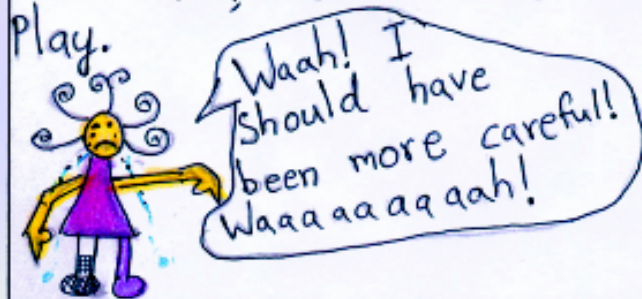
She was then given a lecture.

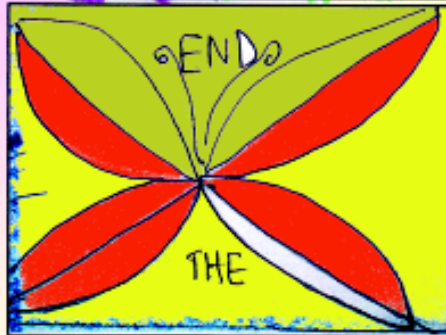
