Describe your Drinking-Water System

The Town of Rainy River water is drawn from a surface water intake located in the Rainy River. The Rainy River is part of the Winnipeg River (Arctic) Watershed. The Water Treatment Plan is a Class II conventional surface water treatment plant that uses coagulation flocculation and sedimentation followed by filtration with a dual media anthracite/sand filter. Filtered water is then disinfected with chlorine gas within a dual chamber clear well with a storage capacity of 1,136 m³. The treated water is then pumped to the distribution system which serves approximately 925 people.
