Imaging a deer so thirsty that its tongue is hanging out and it is taking short breathes while trying to lap fresh water into its mouth for a simple drink.

The Trinity United Church of Christ, Elliston Church Council met on June 13th, 2016 at 7:00 pm. Amy Mathews, President called the meeting to order at 7:01 pm. and Dwayne Hoeft opened with prayer. Those in attendance were as follows:

President – Amy Mathews, Vice President – Ed Gahler, Recording Secretary – Desirae McCloskey, Financial Secretary, Nyla Denman, Deacons – Dwayne Hoeft and Jim Buhro, Elders - Ken Gahler and Connie Gahler, Trustees – Marty Hoeft and Steve Turnow. Pastor Kyle Timmons and Church secretary Rhonda Mahaney was present as well. Absent: Doug Avery and Dale Bodnar

Reports:

Recording Secretary: Meeting minutes from the last council meeting on 5/9/2016 were read prior to the meeting. Motion to accept the minutes for the past meeting was made by Jim Buhro, 2nd by Steve Turnow. MC.

Congregational meeting minutes from the 5/15/2016 meeting were silently read during the meeting. Two amendments were made to the congregational meeting minutes as proposed by Marty Hoeft.

Marty Hoeft made a motion to accept the congregational meeting minutes as amended. Connie Gahler 2nd.

Secretary Report: Nothing to report.

Financial Report:

- Financial information was reviewed. A request was made to separate the EFY Balance into the following two accounts – Branching Out and Youth Group. Jim Buhro moved to accept the financial report. Desirae McCloskey 2nd. MC.
- A six month audit needs to be completed for January thru June and be presented during the July council meeting.
- Rummage sale made \$1,080.35.
 - \$25 will be removed from that total to pay for the excess printing that was for flyers.
 - \$177.55 needs to be moved into the youth account that was made from the concessions stand.

Pastor Report:

- A funeral and a baptism were performed since the last meeting.
- Pastor Kyle asked for the following vacation days: August 15th-19th, October 17th-21st, December 26th-30th. Desirae McCloskey made a motion to accept the vacation days as requested. Steve Turnow 2nd. MC
- Kyle wanted to bring to councils attention that Christmas falls on a Sunday, so wanted to have council think about whether we will have Sunday service on that day, in addition to the Christmas Eve service on Saturday night.
- Pastor Kyle is currently looking into outdoor signage for the church, which will replace the signs that are currently looking outdated. No update to provide.
- Pastor Kyle is currently spending approximately 30 working hours in the church and 10 working hours at home.
- Pastor Kyle and Ed Gahler will look into purchasing additional tables for the church.
 These individuals will present back to council at the July Meeting.
