coming of our Savior Jesus Christ.

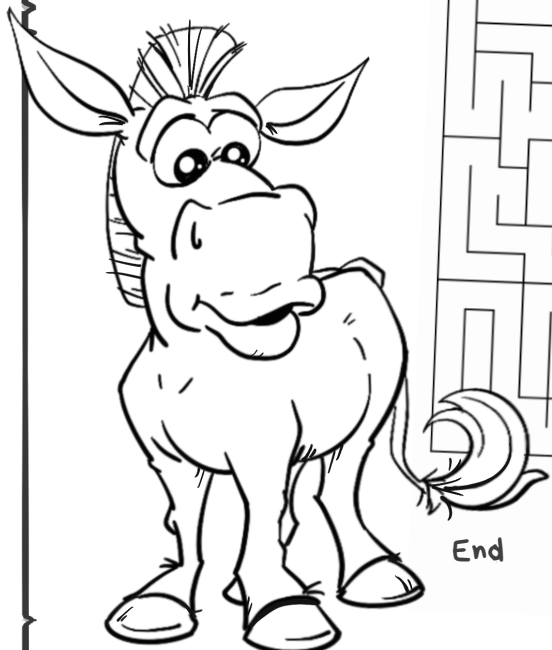

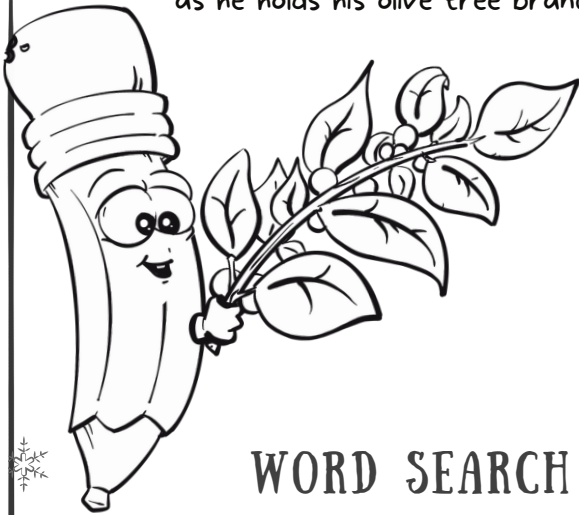

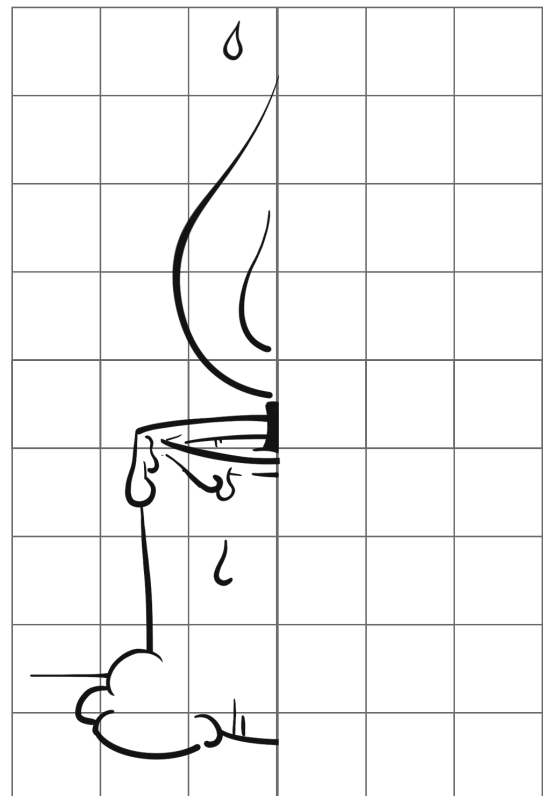
