ORDINANCE NO. 16-__ THE CITY OF VIENNA, ILLINOIS

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 31.040 (MAYOR'S SALARY) OF CHAPTER 31 (EMPLOYEES AND OFFICIALS) OF TITLE 3 (ADMINISTRATION) OF THE VIENNA CODE OF ORDINANCES

Α.	WHEREAS, Section 5/3.1-50-5 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-
50-5) confers	the authority upon municipalities to fix the salary of its municipal officers by
ordinance.	, and the control of

- B. WHEREAS, Section 145/2 of the Local Government Officer Compensation Act (50 ILCS 145/2) requires the level of compensation for elected officials to be fixed 180 or more days prior to the date when such officials take office.
- C. WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Vienna have determined that it is necessary to amend the compensation for the Mayor of the City of Vienna.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Vienna as follows:

1. That Section 31.040 (MAYOR'S SALARY) of Chapter 31 (EMPLOYEES AND OFFICIALS) of Title 3 (ADMINISTRATION) of the Vienna Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as follows:

The mayor shall receive compensation of a monthly salary of \$400. The Mayor shall also receive \$250 \$300 a month for auto expenses. He or she shall be entitled to reimbursement for actual expenses incurred by him or her in the performance of his or her duties.

- 2. This ordinance repeals any prior ordinances, resolutions, or portions thereof in conflict herewith.
- 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication, as required by law and shall amend the compensation of the mayor upon taking office.

RESOLUTION NO. 16-____ THE CITY OF VIENNA, ILLINOIS

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING COMPENSATION FOR THE VIENNA CITY CLERK

- A. WHEREAS, Section 5/3.1-50-5 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-50-5) confers the authority upon municipalities to fix the salary of its municipal officers by ordinance.
- B. WHEREAS, Section 31.073 (SALARY) of Chapter 31 (EMPLOYEES AND OFFICIALS) of Title 3 (ADMINISTRATION) provides that the Vienna City Clerk shall be paid a salary in an amount that may be established from time to time by the Vienna City Council.
- C. WHEREAS, Section 145/2 of the Local Government Officer Compensation Act (50 ILCS 145/2) requires the level of compensation for elected officials to be fixed 180 or more days prior to the date when such officials take office.
- D. WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Vienna have determined that it is necessary to establish the compensation for the Vienna City Clerk of the City of Vienna.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Vienna as follows:

- 1. The Vienna City Clerk shall receive as compensation a yearly salary of \$35,000. In addition, the Vienna City Clerk shall also receive a monthly stipend of \$900 in lieu of health insurance coverage. Due to payment of said stipend, the Vienna City Clerk shall not be eligible for health insurance benefits with the City of Vienna.
- 2. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication, as required by law and shall establish the compensation of the Vienna City Clerk upon taking office.
