## December 2015 Block of the Month: Ornament

Block finishes at 12" (unfinished at $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ). Materials:

White fabric: $2-13 / 4 " \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips

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\text { 1-2" x } 12 \text { 1/2" strip }
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Red fabric: 2-13/4" x 30 " strips
Subcut: $\quad 2-13 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
2-1 3/4" x $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
Blue fabric: $\quad 1-13 / 4$ " $\times 35$ " strip
Subcut: $\quad 4-13 / 4 " \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
4-13/4" x 2 1/2" strips
4-13/4" x 3 1/2" strips
1-2" x 30" strip
Subcut:
2-2" x 12.5" strips
Construction:
Sew a $31 / 2$ " blue strip to each end of both $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ red strips. Sew a 2 1/2" blue strip to each end of both $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white strips. Sew a $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ blue strip to each end of both $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ red strips. Press all the strips smooth.

Layout strips in this sequence: $61 / 2$ red center, $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white center, 10 1/2" red center, $121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white strip, $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ red center, $81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ white center, and finally the last $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ red center. Sew together, adding a blue 2 " $\times 12$
 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip to the top and bottom, press, and measure. Block should be 12 1/2".
***Remember your $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.***
You can choose to make a complete quilt top by repeating these instructions or you can set this block aside and make a sampler quilt. We look forward to seeing everyone's blocks.
