DESCRIPTION: The RARE (produced in 1969 only) H-30 was the top of the popular Pearson "H" line ((H-30, H-52. H-70, and H-90). The H-30 had a very similar design as the famed Mercury Hunter, but without the mercury capsules. The H-30 was scaled down a bit in 1970 and renamed the Sierra Stalker. This is a substantial man's bow. Freijo riser. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Double-sided overlay tips. Beveled arrow shelf. Overlays and tips are in great condition. 2 hardly visible filled screw holes on the side of the riser (see pic). No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in excellent condition. There are a couple of finish issues on the side of the riser near the filled screw holes that can only be seen very close up. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow sold for \$80 in 69, which translates to \$567 in 2020 inflation adjusted dollars.
