


Crossroads continues to grow in many directions. Summer 2017 proved to be different than the past. God is funny that way, just when we think we have it figured it out, He continues to stretch us in new and exciting ways for His glory. All areas of the ministry carried out the Gospel message of Christ to the county through the summer months. Many mission team members came and began their life on mission and not just a mission trip.

The Lord's Café celebrated 6 years of serving meals in June. We are so thankful for this avenue to meet not only the physical needs but the spiritual needs. Over the past six years, many relationships have been formed. Some are ongoing and others have been for a season. We continue to pray "God show us the need, and provide the resources." He is faithfully continuing to do just that!

Each week in the summer, lunch was served at The Lord's Café four days a week. We averaged nearly 800 meals a week served. On Wednesdays, more than 100 families received groceries at the giveaway. Those are the resources. The ministry truly takes place around the table at lunch four days a week, during devotion, in the food line, and praying in the parking lot on Wednesdays. The ministry multiplies as churches who partner experience God at work then go home with a

new awareness of needs at home.

The Learning Center continues to stay active. This summer, Day Camp was awesome! God is allowing us to minister in new ways to families. Many of the children involved in children's ministry as




children involved in children's ministry are being raised by someone other than a biological parent. God is providing many grandparents, aunts, uncles, and foster parents to raise children who have already experienced much hurt in life. Through our personal journey, God has opened new conversations and awareness of needs of these families. This summer, several of the children had never heard the Gospel. Thankfully, now the seeds have been planted and some have been harvested! Our prayer continues to be that Scripture is not just head knowledge, but that Scripture through the power of the Holy Spirit will bring hope. Throughout the summer, the kids at Day Camp complete nearly 70 Bible lessons.



We have relaunched after school tutoring this school year. Now, after school tutoring is call Kid'z Korner! We welcome kids Tuesdays and Thursdays from after school until 6PM. God continues to bless the kids as they receive not only homework help, but both spiritual and physical nutrient. We are praying for more volunteers so we can expand this ministry.

The Light Community is still very much in the infancy stage of ministry. Throughout the summer months, we took mission teams on site for one night of devotion and debrief to share the vision. Much work has been done on the prayer chapel and two outhouses. In addition, clearing of the land has been an ongoing job. The property sat vacant for three years. In addition to land clean up, many areas of the property have been cleaned out. This week, we met with state inspectors from different departments along with a waste water company. It is amazing to see God work out the details.

Many logistical pieces are all moving ahead. God allowed me a national platform to share the ministries of Crossroads, especially The Light Community, in Nashville at the Religious News Association Conference (RNA). In addition, returning and new groups are making plans to come to Kentucky as early as spring to begin construction of the homes in the community. We are also raising funding for some important infrastructure components of the community. The costliest component will be waste water. We continue to pray for support and more importantly, favor from God.



Fall and winter outreach ministries are being planned. In October, the ladies for Heritage Hills Baptist in Conyers, Georgia return for the ladies' retreat. This will be held overnight at The Learning Center and is open to the ladies in our area to attend. On October 21, The Learning Center will be transformed into winter clothing land for our annual coat giveaway. This year, in addition to our age and gender clothing areas, we are adding a hunting clothing room. We are still accepting donations for this event up to the day before the event.

Saturday, November 18, we will host our seventh annual Community Thanksgiving Dinner. This year we are preparing for 1,600 for the day. Several churches have already begun collecting food items for the dinner. We are currently signing up for volunteers. If you would like to know how you can help, email or call us.

The Learning Center turns in the first century Bethlehem on Saturday, December 9, as we welcome families to the annual Christmas Backpack Giveaway. We are excited to expand the living nativity this year with more interactive activities for the children. In addition, "Deacon", our donkey from The Light Community, will be making his stage debut during the event. We are still accepting backpacks and volunteers for this event as well.



What started as "Quarters For Kentucky" and laundry ministry is now becoming a new faith family! God continues to allow visions to become reality. On Sunday, September 3, a group from FBC Centre Alabama, held the first worship service at the Pine Knot laundry mat. Pine Knot Community Church is the name of this new church. Over the next several months, the team from Alabama will be returning to Kentucky to hold worship services on the first Sunday of the month. Pray for this new church start and for the partnership to continue to grow into a healthy union for God's glory.

Spring and summer mission teams are booking now. If you are interested in coming to Kentucky to be on missions, please do not wait to book your trip. In addition to mission teams, we are recruiting college interns. Our partnership with the University of the Cumberlands will not continue for summer 2018. We are beginning now to recruit college students willing to serve for the summer. Will your church send a student or two? Internships will be beginning at the end of May and continue through the first week of August. We are looking for interns who are in the Word and ready to be used by God.
