The Gift of **Exhortation**

Description: This gift **encourages** members to be involved in and enthusiastic about the **work** of the Lord. Members with this gift are good **counselors** and motivate others to **service**.

Example of Worship: **David**

Passage: 1 Samuel 16:23, "And whenever the evil spirit from God came upon Saul, David took the lyre and played it with his hand, and Saul would be relieved and feel better, and the evil spirit would depart from him."

Notes: By this time the Spirit of god had departed of Saul because of his disobedience and David has been anointed. Saul would constantly request David because of his gift of worship. Saul was being tormented by a spirit that was sent by God and David, when operating in his gift of worship, the spirit would depart from Saul.

Example of Exhortation: **Paul**

Passage: Ephesians 1:15-16 Paul never stops giving thanks. 1 Cor Paul is always thankful, and declares that are enriched everyday by the father. Phillipians. Paul is always thankful when reminded of them. Colossians, Paul is thankful for their faith in Christ. 1 & 2 Tim, Paul encourages Timothy in his ministry.

Notes: Paul, whether he was answering questions from the church he planted or just keeping in contact, or correcting a groups of believers always encouraged those believes.

Example of Giving: **Barnabas**

Passage: Acts 4:36-37, “36 There was a Levite, a native of Cyprus, Joseph, to whom the apostles gave the name Barnabas (which means “son of encouragement”). 37 He sold a field that belonged to him, then brought the money, and laid it at the apostles’ feet.

Notes: Bible scholars also believe that Barnabas was t=the rich young ruler who could not sell all his possessions and follow Jesus. We may miss an opportunity to use our gifts, but God will also continue to move to give you another opportunity.

Example of Service: **Church**

Passage: Acts 6:2-3, “So the twelve summoned the community of disciples and[g] said, “It is not desirable that we neglect the word of God to serve tables. 3 So, brothers, select from among you seven men of good reputation,[h] full of the Spirit and wisdom, whom we will put in charge of this need.

Notes: The disciple decided to those because the church and been given food and other essential items but the need was so large that they need to appoint lead person to oversees the meeting of this need.
