TRUSTEE 5/07:

Many of you have probably already heard that our 440 spectrum on the West Coast is in danger of repeaters being shut down or lowering the power to as much as 5 watts. The ARRL sent out a list of 105 repeaters affected. If they do not comply with power restrictions they will be told to shut down by the FCC. The maximum power at present is 50 watts. The 4Cs was not on that list. I will keep up on it as it develops. We are hoping there will be some mitigation. This is not an issue for NARCC as they only do coordination. The reason for this is to accommodate the Air Force Radar over the horizon operation.
