At the conference I attended this past spring in Loveland we were challenged by the guest speaker. He felt most Disciple churches have lost

their historic language. He was very blunt when he said, "We must reclaim our historical language, or we will die." I must say, it is a statement I have been thinking about ever since he made it. So, I have decided to open the conversation and invite you to the next Bible Study series I will be leading to discuss and address this thought. I am excited to hear what you have to say about it.

Because of the excitement, I want to start advertising early. In September we will start a Bible Study series about the history and polity of the Disciples of Christ. September 5th at 11:30 AM and 6:30 PM (Pick one!) The class will go on Thursdays until October 17th. Seven weeks, I hope you can find free time to attend (pack your lunch if you come to the 11:30 study, totally fine to do. I guess you could bring your lunch to the 6:30 session too ..but that just seems weird to me.)

The founding principle of the Disciple movement was a simple one. God welcomes All. This is the cause upon which we were founded (and after the class you might argue that previous statement isn't 100% correct.) Through the course of study, I hope you will see and find this to be the driving force that is still alive and well today in our church and denomination. It is this statement ...not Robert's Rules ...that should drive our church polity/life.

In a world that is ever more splintered into sides we as Disciples are uniquely positioned to share this unifying statement; "In essentials, unity; in doubtful matters, liberty; in all things, charity." Why? Because we were born out of a quest to demonstrate that God welcomes all. Even when we disagree on the most divisive of issues ...we can still unite around Christ. Or at least I hope we still can.



Have you been to the neighborhood Save-A-Lot since they remodeled?

For the last year and a half plus, Save-A-Lot has been working to provide more than just lower cost groceries to their neighbors. Last March they launched their Snap2Save Mobile Application. An app that helps customers: Save Money, Live Healthy.

Along with digital couponing and special offers, (similar to other big chain stores), the app helps users earn points for in-store gift cards or health care rebates. The Snap2Save app also has an EBT Trakker component to strengthen financial management for the user.

To give neighbors incentives to Live Healthy, the Snap2Save app increases wellness and buying power with Healthy Food Rewards. These rewards can be used to support clinical dietary prescriptions. Through the app, users can receive healthy recipes and wellness information. There are also reduced costs or incentives at health care/wellness partners.

Save-A-Lot and Snap2Save have increased their response to their neighbors' Live Healthy goals by partnering with the American Diabetes Association and are presenting the Diabetes Food Hub. As part of the Snap2Save app, users can access the Diabetes Food Hub and be able to easily navigate an online healthy eating resource that includes Recipes, Meal Planner, Grocery List, a Blog with Health Tips, and more. The partnership with the ADA is also providing a Diabetes At-Risk Test. The short 60-second test that you can take for yourself or a loved one is available through the app or online: <u>http://www.diabetes.org/are-you-at-risk/diabetes-risk-test/</u>.

Central Christian Church is helping to spread the word to neighbors through this article and future announcements in the bulletins and Weekly Updates. Snap2Save has set a goal of getting 10,000 individuals to take the Diabetes-At-Risk Test in El Paso County, Pueblo County, and Southern Colorado by the end of the year.

If you haven't done so, check out the improved neighborhood Save-A-Lot, download the app, and take the Diabetes-At-Risk Test. (Make sure you include your zip code for tracking toward the 10,000 people goal.) Then tell your neighbors to do the same.
