Lifeline and Link-Up

Lifeline reduces the basic monthly charge for one telephone line for income-eligible households. Link-Up helps households without telephone service, get it and those with service, keep it when they move. Pays for most of the installation charges of one telephone.

Provides a FREE SafeLink wireless phone plus up to 250 free minutes every month. (Minutes can be added at a cost.) Eligibility: People who are already on BadgerCare, Food Stamps, SSI, MA can qualify automatically. Otherwise you must have a household income of 135% FPG (must provide proof) and no one else in the household can have a SafeLink phone.
