Steer & Heifer Show Rules & Regulations

- All entry fees are due at check in. ****NO PAYMENT, NO SHOW**** cash, cashier's check and money orders will be accepted.
- Please have your tickets and vehicle pass with you for admittance inside the livestock gate.
- The Livestock Gate will be CLOSED at 12 NOON. If you are arriving after 12 NOON, please park in the parking lot and come through the ticket booths. Make sure if you are hauling tack, Please be at the fairgrounds before 12 NOON.
- All animals will be dehorned and must be of show quality.
- All animals must be halter broken and shown at halter.
- Exhibitor& Parent must sign entry forms. Forms will be returned if it is not signed.
- All steers and heifers must be checked in between 9:00am and 12:00pm and in place no later than 12:00pm the day of the show.
- The show will start promptly at 2:00pm.
- ****All Heifers must be born on or after January 1, 2019.**
- All animals must have an official health certificate.
- ****All commercial heifer classes will be determined by weight and will be shown in one show.****
There will be no re-weighs after heifers are checked in.
- ****All registered heifers will be shown by British or Exotic by age.****
- All steer classes will be determined by weight. There will be no re-weighs after steers are checked in.
- All tack and trim chutes will be restricted to designated areas.
- No nails or screws will be used in barn facility.
- Waste must be disposed of in assigned area. ****Please keep your space clean.****
- Exhibitors must show their own animal unless he/she has more than one animal in the same class.
- Exhibitors must show their own animal in showmanship class.
- Neck ropes must be used for securing animals and will be provided by exhibitor.
- Prize money will be awarded based upon available funds.
- The show committee reserves the right to change, combine, or delete classes with insufficient entries.
- The decisions made by the show committee regarding show rules and regulations will be final.
- All complaints must be filed with the show committee on the day of the show. Exhibitor must fill out a complaint form explaining grievance. These will be available at the show desk the day of the show.
- **Due to Covid-19, the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair will follow all necessary guidelines set forth by the Governor, the CDC, and the local government. A list of guidelines will be sent with your fair passes.**
