Wally Pikal – Wally Pikal, when a senior in high school, played his first professional job with the Jerry Dostal Band. Playing trumpet, Wally learned to play two and even three at the same time. In 1950 his Band “Wally & the Dill Pickles” began and continued for thirty years. He also owned a music store in Hutchinson. Wally’s one-man vaudeville show (playing two trumpets, while jumping on a pogo stick) earned him fame on national television shows. Today Wally has a weekly radio show and still entertains audiences.
