8	agreed to let me use this property until we wanted to
9	buy it and purchase it. And I grew up with him. They
LO	rode horses there.
11	Q So Jimmy did Mr. Marsh, who you had the
12	handshake agreement with, what was his first name?
L3	A That was Richie.
14	Q Did he have two sons?
15	A Yes. Richie and Jimmy.
16	Q And when did the senior Richie, when did he
17	pass away?
18	A I can't tell you for sure the date.
19	Q '90s?
20	A I can't tell you the date. But Jim and
21	Rich, they knew they were leery of the government like
22	so many people are. So they said, "We will just sell
23	it to you, then we won't have a problem."

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A Yes. I indicated this several times. This to me is very important. This here is an irrigation ditch put in in the '50s. And all this here is the back side of that.

This here ditch starts here and goes across the culvert on Sharp Road. This comes up around and bypasses what you guys called Elk Creek which I don't. This has been flooded now. It's been flooded for 60, 70 years.

Q Where is the irrigation ditch, if you could highlight it in yellow.

A It's the one here, the ditch that comes up through. The ditch we keep talking about.

Q That goes all the way down?

A The agricultural ditch. This has been flooded like I said, when the beaver come in there in the '30s and '40s, that's been flooded. I have an affidavit stating that. This is wet. I never denied it.

Q Are you saying you dug this ditch?

A Yes.

Q What year?

A This here. Again, when they put this dam in in the '50s, my uncle used this for irrigation.

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Then the bypass, all this water come around this end of the dam.

Q Just for the record, the witness is referring to parcel ID31016063.00100, which is actually the property north of what we have been identifying as the Marsh site?

A This a man in New York owns this now. I have an agreement with him to keep this channel open. But this here, I guess, had been flooded all these years. I have an affidavit when I started this. There is never no bed and bank in any of that. I testified to that.

Q Your handshake agreement with Richie Marsh, Sr., was allowing you to dig or excavate that ditch that begins up at the parcel above his property and then down through it?

A Yes. Because the beaver in here, again being this here was a dam that was put in there years and years ago, Jim and I agreed that this would help both of us. This would make his property better, make our property better. He said do what you need to do to get it productive.

When the law changed in '85, that is when I went to the conservation district, when I did these other properties, and I have and should have an

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1	exclusionary deal on this corner that is a CW.
