Plaster Bench Technician - Fairport Harbor, Ohio

[Part Time- Entry Level]

In collaboration with the Lead Technician, the Plaster Bench Technician will focus on entry level model pouring, duplicating and plaster and stone processes in a dental laboratory setting.

Key responsibilities include:

- Read prescriptions or specifications and examine models or impressions to determine the type of dental products to be constructed.
- Constructs models of the mouth and teeth from impressions of the patient's mouth taken by the dentist; encasing wax in a mold material and melting away the wax.
- Create a model of patient's mouth by pouring plaster into a dental impression and allowing plaster to set.
- Place tooth models on apparatus that mimics bite and movement of patient's jaw to evaluate functionality of model.
- Documents actions by completing forms, reports, logs, and records.
- Operates and maintains a variety of dental laboratory tools and equipment such as trimmers, grinders, lathes, articulators, and cleaning devices.
- Utilizes and conserves supplies and equipment by completing plaster casting and sandblasting; maintaining supplies inventories; keeping equipment operating.
- Assists with maintaining established departmental policies and procedures, objectives, and quality improvement, safety, and environmental and infection control standards.
- Keep supplies stocked and organized in clinic cabinets; report inventory of supplies as needed while following budgetary guidelines as outlined by the management.

Successful candidates will have:

- Possess better than average ability to pay attention to details.
- Proficient communicative, auditory, and visual skills are needed.
- Self-motivated with the willingness to exceed patient expectations.
- Demonstrated adaptability and flexibility with changes in workload.
