

# **Certificates of Achievement in Creating Sustainable Neighborhood Developers' Program by Southern University EDA University Center for Economic and Entrepreneurial Development**

- **What is the Certificate of Achievement (COA)?**

The COA is a verifying document that an individual **sufficiently** obtained fundamental knowledge on sustainable neighborhood development and **passed** the program exam administered by SUEDA University Center for Economic and Entrepreneurial Development.

- **Who is eligible for taking the exam?**

Anyone who registered for and attended the six-week program (*a minimum of five attendances*) is eligible for taking the exam.

# • **About the Sustainable Neighborhood Developer Exam**

In general, the exam consists of 9 topic areas:

- (1) The State of Real Estate Development and Acquisition
- (2) Capacity Building and Funding Sources
- (3) Housing Policy and Strategic Housing Advocacy
- (4) QuickBooks
- (5) License, Certifications, and Insurance
- (6) Understanding Construction Drawings
- (7) Construction Beyond the Housing Development Award in a Present COVID World
- (8) Xactimate
- (9) Project management

Specifically,

The exam consists of 80 multiple-choice questions that are based on oral and written presentations (i.e. PowerPoints, PDFs, etc.), as well as any additional specific assignments made by the course trainers over the six-week program.

- **How to prepare for the exam**

- (1) Weekly practice questions have been posted on the Center's website: [www.subruniversitycenter.org](http://www.subruniversitycenter.org)
- (2) These practice questions were based on oral and written presentations, as well as any additional specific assignments made by the course trainers.
- (3) The actual certification exam questions are structured in the same format as the weekly practice questions.
- (4) One practice exam (80 questions) that mimics the actual exam will be posted on the Center's website on Saturday, November 27, 2021.

- **When and where to take the exam**

The virtual exam will be given on two different dates:

(1) Saturday, December 4, 2021, 8:30-10:30 a.m., CST

(2) Saturday, December 11, 2021, 8:30-10:30 a.m., CST

## **How to acquire the Certificate of Achievement in the CSNDs' Program**

- Get at least 70% (56 out of 80) of the exam questions right.
