Financial Update: download October's financial update <u>HERE</u>. October income showed a surplus of \$7,567, leaving Eastside in good shape for the year. The year-to-date surplus is \$7,010 and the bank balance (counting the Whitmore Park reserve) is \$50,905. PAR giving was flat to September, and the LSC account maintains a healthy balance of \$35,868. This is also an end of the year reminder to get donations in for the end of the tax season!

November's financial update is available to view <u>HERE</u>. November was another strong month for Eastside's finances, with a surplus of \$789. This brings the year to date surplus to \$7,799. Revenue is \$1,147 ahead of budget, and expenses are \$6,652 below budget. As noted last month, the

key factor that has kept expenses below budget is the amounts recovered from the disability insurance plan from Russell's absence in the summer.
