1-1. Our Name

A. The “Y” is the first letter of the English transliteration of this Hebrew word:



B. It is pronounced öYeshua.ö It is the actual name of öJesusö who was born about 6 BCE and crucified by the Roman army about 27 CE. Our focus is on the öYeshua of History,ö not the öJesus of Conflicting Theologies.ö

1-2. We Are a Team

A. A team is a group of people from diverse backgrounds with different life experiences and skills.

B. A team is a group of people who perform the same and different tasks as they work together to accomplish common objectives and goals.

C. A team is a group of people that demonstrate their mutual support through their actions.

1-3. Leadership Model

A. öYö Team Leadership follows a coaching model.

1. Introducing Team Members to new information.
2. Helping Team Members understand the information.
3. Guiding Team Members on how to do what they learn.
4. Coordinating action between Team Members.

B. öYö Team Members are being trained to be öYö Team Coaches.
