Meal: WOSA will provide all tableware, chicken from Giant, and drinks. We'll eat in Joe's garage so don't worry about the weather.

Please bring a covered dish or dessert.

Before the Picnic: We'll do some fun activities, walk some trails to see native wildflower plots, and catch up on the news.

Directions:

From points **west** of McConnellsburg: (it takes about 40 minutes from Everett)

Follow Route 30 east, **stay on Route 30** past the McConnellsburg Route 522 exit (continue up the mountain for 1.9 miles). Turn right onto Rt. 30 East Lincoln Highway. **Note: this exit is not well marked so watch carefully as you drive up the mountain 1.9 miles).** Follow Lincoln Highway down the mountain for 0.7 miles. Watch for WOSA sign and balloons at 1355 Lincoln Way on your left.

From points **east** of McConnellsburg- Follow Route 30 west to the McConnellsburg Lincoln Highway exit. Turn left onto Lincoln Highway and follow down the mountain for 0.7 miles to balloons and WOSA sign on the left.

From points **North** and **South**- Follow Route 522 to the intersection with Route 30. Follow Route 30 east up the mountain 1.9 miles to the intersection with Rt. 30 East Lincoln Highway. Turn right and follow Lincoln Highway down the mountain 0.7 miles to WOSA sign and balloons on the left.
