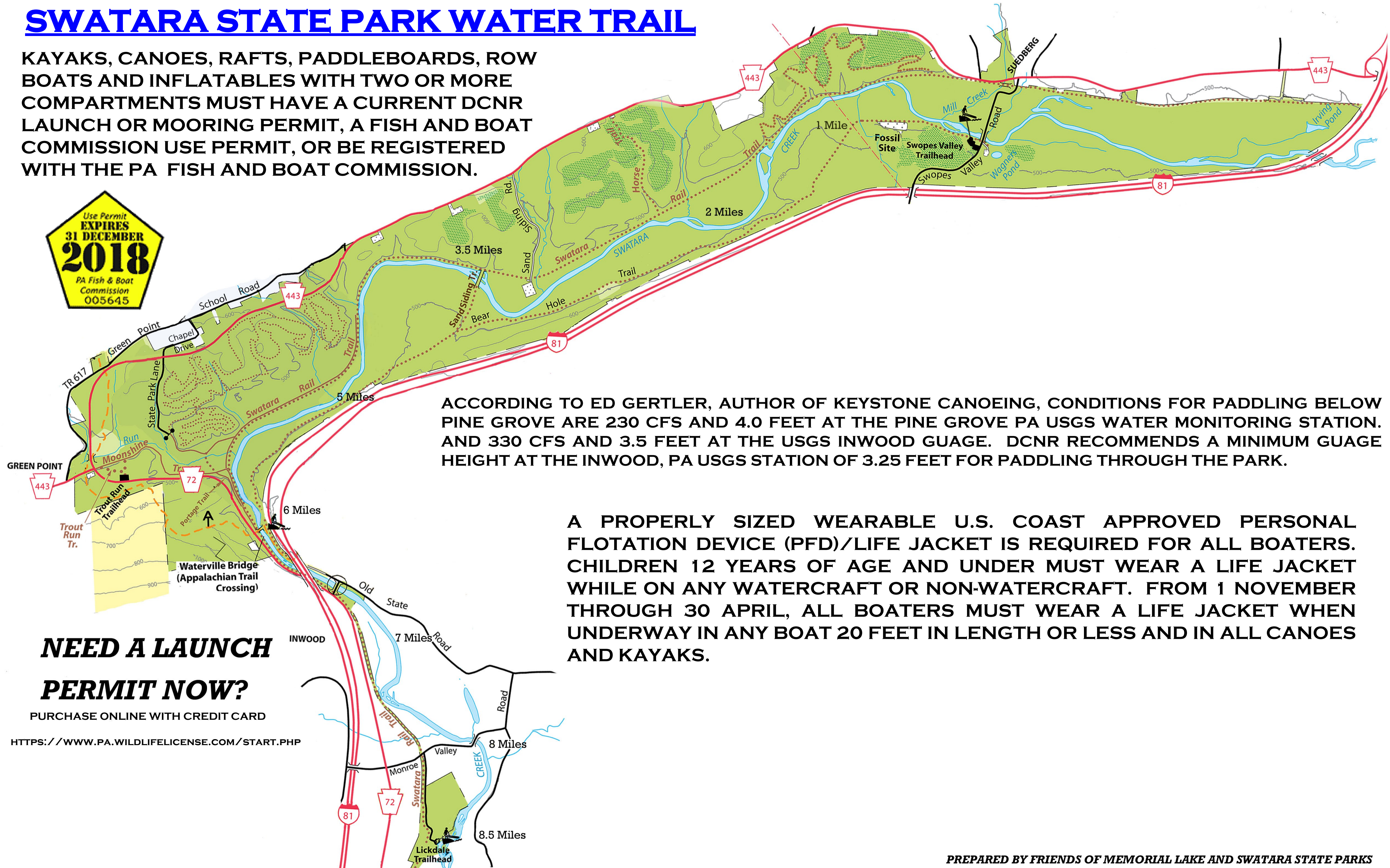


SWATARA STATE PARK WATER TRAIL

KAYAKS, CANOES, RAFTS, PADDLEBOARDS, ROW BOATS AND INFLATABLES WITH TWO OR MORE COMPARTMENTS MUST HAVE A CURRENT DCNR LAUNCH OR MOORING PERMIT, A FISH AND BOAT COMMISSION USE PERMIT, OR BE REGISTERED WITH THE PA FISH AND BOAT COMMISSION.



ACCORDING TO ED GERTLER, AUTHOR OF KEYSTONE CANOEING, CONDITIONS FOR PADDLING BELOW PINE GROVE ARE 230 CFS AND 4.0 FEET AT THE PINE GROVE PA USGS WATER MONITORING STATION. AND 330 CFS AND 3.5 FEET AT THE USGS INWOOD GAUGE. DCNR RECOMMENDS A MINIMUM GAUGE HEIGHT AT THE INWOOD, PA USGS STATION OF 3.25 FEET FOR PADDLING THROUGH THE PARK.

A PROPERLY SIZED WEARABLE U.S. COAST APPROVED PERSONAL FLOTATION DEVICE (PFD)/LIFE JACKET IS REQUIRED FOR ALL BOATERS. CHILDREN 12 YEARS OF AGE AND UNDER MUST WEAR A LIFE JACKET WHILE ON ANY WATERCRAFT OR NON-WATERCRAFT. FROM 1 NOVEMBER THROUGH 30 APRIL, ALL BOATERS MUST WEAR A LIFE JACKET WHEN UNDERWAY IN ANY BOAT 20 FEET IN LENGTH OR LESS AND IN ALL CANOES AND KAYAKS.
