

Payments

Current tax statement payments may be made at with your original statement at the Parma Township Office (a drop slot is available) or mailed to the address at the top of your statement.

Checks are accepted for payment of taxes. NSF checks will be returned and a service charge of \$35.00 will be added to checks returned from the bank. Taxes then must be paid by cash.

It is always helpful to write your telephone number and property tax ID number on your check.

Partial Payments of Taxes

Parma Township will accept partial payments of taxes.

Tax Receipts

Tax receipts are available by fax, email, or U.S. mail for taxes paid in the current year or for any previous year. There is no charge for requesting tax receipts. Please call the Treasurer for assistance on researching this information at (517) 629-8277.

Failure to Receive Tax Statement

Failure to receive a tax statement does not exempt you from penalties when taxes become delinquent. Change of address should be promptly reported. If you have funds escrowed with your mortgage company to pay your taxes, please make certain they received the statement. If you are responsible for paying directly to Parma Township and have not received a statement within 30 days of July 1st and/or December 30th please contact us.

Statement of Right to Appeal - Primary Residence Only
