

ORDINANCE NO: 19-1171

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A NEW SCHEDULE OF FINES FOR
TRAFFIC AND NON-TRAFFIC VIOLATIONS FOR
MAYOR'S COURT IN THE VILLAGE OF RUSSELLS POINT, OHIO**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has mandatory court costs to be submitted through the Reparations Rotary Reporting to fund the state's public defender's office, and

WHEREAS, an increase in Mayor's Court fines has not occurred since 2014 and adjustments to costs are needed to be in line with neighboring courts, and

WHEREAS, Mayor's Court is established to protect the health, welfare, and safety of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Russells Point, Ohio:

SECTION I: A new schedule of fines is hereby established as follows:

A. Speeding:

<u>Amount Exceeding Posted Limit</u>	<u>First Offense In 12 Months</u>	<u>Second Offense In 12 Months</u>
1-10 mph	\$110.00	\$135.00
11-15 mph	\$130.00	\$180.00
16-20 mph	\$140.00	\$215.00
21-25 mph	\$170.00	\$270.00
26 mph or over	Mandatory Appearance	Mandatory Appearance

Mandatory appearance in Bellefontaine Municipal Court after 3rd offense in 12 months.

B. Seat Belt:	<u>Person</u>	<u>Fine</u>
	Driver	\$90.00
	Passenger	\$80.00
	Child Restraint	\$110.00

C. All other Traffic and Non-Traffic Violations \$110.00

D. Court Costs: \$95.00

E. Parking Violations \$35.00, \$45.00 after 3rd day of issuance.

F. Impound Fees \$25.00/day

G. Bench Warrant Fee \$35.00


H. NSF Transaction Fee \$35.00

SECTION II: All prior legislation, or any parts thereof, which is/are inconsistent with this Ordinance is/are hereby repealed as to the inconsistent parts thereto.


SECTION III: That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION IV: That this ordinance shall, therefore, be in force and take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.


