**FABRIC: Refer to the photo**

Light color A (Golden)	¼ yd	Block Centers
Light Color B (Blue-Gr)	¼ yd	Block Centers
Medium Color A	¼ yd	Block
Use 4 different fabrics	(EACH)	Middle Row
Medium Color B	¼ yd	Block
Use 4 different fabrics	(EACH)	Middle Row
Dark Color A	1/3 yd	Block
Use 4 different fabrics	(EACH)	Outer Row
Dark Color B	1/3 yd	Block
Use 4 different fabrics	(EACH)	Outer Row
Mottled Dark Fabric	¾ yd	Outer Border
Mottled Dark Fabric	1/2 yd	Binding
Various scraps of above are used for the appliqué animals		

Supplies:

- heavy duty fusible web such as Heat and Bond
- rotary cutter
- rotary cutting board
- rulers (12", 24", etc.)
- iron and ironing board
- scissors
- straight pins
- sewing machine in working order (bring manual)
- bobbins
- thread
- extra sewing machine needles
- extension cords
- multi socket outlet
- seam ripper
- general sewing kit

**PREPARATION FOR CLASS:** Please cut your fabric according to the cutting directions attached.

Group "A" is the golden/moose group and Group "B" is the blue-green/bear group.  
Cut the following for EACH group and keep groups separated to avoid confusion. Place  
cut pieces in separate ziplock baggies and label each.

Cut (7) 2.5" squares of the one light group A fabric

Cut (8) 5" x 6.5" rectangles of the one light group A fabric

Cut (8) 2.5" squares of the one light group B fabric

Cut (7) 5" x 6.5" rectangles of the one light group B fabric

\*\*\*\*NOTE: THE DIFFERENT NUMBER NEEDED FOR EACH GROUP IS RIGHT!!

Cut (1) 1.5" strip of each of the 4 medium colors in each group, A & B

Cut (2) 1.5" strips of each of the 4 dark colors in each group, A & B
