

**CITY OF HARDIN, TEXAS
ORDINANCE NO. 2016 - #02-05-13**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF HARDIN, TEXAS, ACTION TAKEN BY CITY COUNCIL ON MAY 19, 2016, IN APPOINTING A CITY SECRETARY; APPOINTING THE CITY SECRETARY AS TREASURER ; AND PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, on May 19, 2016, the City Council of the City of Hardin, Texas (“City”), appointed Lana Webb as City Secretary; and

WHEREAS, City Council also desires to appoint Lana Webb as City Treasurer;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARDIN, TEXAS:

Section 1. The facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct and incorporated herein for all purposes.

Section 2. The City Council of the City of Hardin, Texas, hereby appoints Lana Webb as City Secretary as approved by the City Council on May 19, 2016.

Section 3. The City Council of the City of Hardin, Texas, hereby appoints Lana Webb as City Treasurer.

Section 4. Lana Webb shall begin full time employment at the City of Hardin as of May 19, 2016, with a salary of \$16.75 / hr.

Section 5. Lana Webb shall be an officer of the City with the powers and duties as set forth in Texas Local Government Code, Chapter 22, as amended.


Section 6. Severability.

In the event any clause, phrase, provision, sentence or part of this Ordinance or application of the same to any person or circumstances shall for any reason be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect, impair, or invalidate this Ordinance as a whole or any part or provision hereof other than the part declared to be invalid or unconstitutional; and the City Council of the City of Hardin, Texas, declares that it would have passed each and every part of the same notwithstanding the omission of any part thus declared to be invalid or unconstitutional, or whether there be one or more parts.
