DESIGN

- ∅ Poster boards are .9 m (width) by 1.5 m (height) (2.9 x 4.9 ft). Posters should fit within these dimensions and not be larger than the board.
- ∅ There is no specific poster design. However, the poster should convey the following information:
 - Title of abstract as it was submitted
 - Author(s) and authors' affiliations
 - The abstract that was submitted for publication
 - The three digit abstract number (for example: 220) in the upper right hand corner
 - Should be written in English
- ∅ Posters should be easy to read from at least a 1 m (~3 ft) distance.

PRESENTING

- ∅ The poster session is on Tuesday, April 5 from 6-8 p.m. The presenting author should be present at his/her poster for the duration of this time period.
 - Posters should be up by 9 a.m. (April 5)
 - Posters should be taken down by 9 p.m. (April 5)
- ∅ A poster session "map" will be available onsite at the registration desk.
 - If you are presenting multiple posters, your posters will be together.
- ∅ Push pins will be provided onsite. If you do not want to use push pins, you must provide alternate hanging materials (i.e., tape, clips, velcro, etc.)

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- ∅ Presenters are encouraged to bring their poster with them to the conference. However, if you must ship them prior to arrival, there will be no charges for receiving posters at the hotel. Presenters can send posters to the hotel **two weeks*** in advance:
