Assignments:

Program Criteria

Age: 13 - 19 years of age

Grades: We encourage our members to work hard in school. All Teen Leaders & Pre-Debs should strive to pass all their school classes. If our member is failing, we will work closely to help her achieve passing grades.

Community Service: Our members are not required to have previous community service experience, however, those who have some background in community service is helpful. Each Teen Leader must complete at least 10 hours of community service before the Debutante Cotillion.

Essay: Teen Leaders must submit a one-page essay titled "I would like to be a part of the Talitha Cumi Urban Etiquette and Leadership S.W.A.G.G. program because...."

Three References: Recommendation letter speaking of the applicants character and potential for your acceptance into the 2019 Talitha Cumi Urban Etiquette and Leadership Teen Leader program.

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Enrichment Hetivities

In addition to meeting the academy criteria, to participate in the Debutante ceremony the following three Developmental criteria must be completed

Developmental Criteria I: Outreach Enrichment
