# REHABILITATE TAXIWAY 'A' AND ASSOCIATED TAXIWAYS (Construct Only)

This Project is for the design and construction phases necessary to rehabilitate Taxiway 'A', install new taxiway edge lighting (MITLs), and to address the grading issues at the intersection of Taxiway 'A' and Taxiway 'D'.

### Project Status:

- The grant to fund this project has been issued to the NAA.
- Upon authorization from the NAA, Gale will prepare the Notice of Award and Contracts for execution.
- Construction will commence in the spring of 2024.
- A Supplemental agreement for Gale's services related to the administration of a second grant is
  required as our original contract did not include the need for two grants for Taxiway 'A'. Gale
  will prepare this agreement and submit it to the NAA for review/comment.
- This grant should be on the agenda for Governor and Council Approval for November 28, 2023.

### REHABILITATE GOLF RAMP AND FOXTROT RAMP

This project is for the design and construction necessary to rehabilitate Golf and Foxtrot Ramps at the Airport.

# **Project Status:**

- The BIL portion of this project's funding has been issued to the NAA.
- Governor & Council approval was obtained at the November 8th meeting.
- Gale will be preparing the next Reimbursement Request for Continental Paving, Inc. for submission/reimbursement. This will complete all contractual obligations between CPI and the NAA.
- Similar to the Taxiway 'A' project, Gale's scope of services did not include administering a second grant for this project. Gale will be processing a supplemental agreement for review/comment of the NAA prior to final reimbursement and closeout.

## **RELOCATE AWOS/SAWS**

This project is for the design, bidding, and construction phase services associated with relocating the existing AWOS/SAWS at the Airport. The weather equipment will be moved to a location between Taxiway 'A' on the 14 end, and Taxiway 'C' and Taxiway 'D' as depicted on the ALP. It is anticipated that this project will be funded using BIL funds.

## **Project Status:**

- The 30% Design has been submitted to FAA and NHDOT for review/comment on October 10, 2023. The review period was estimated to be approximately 14 days, however we have not received review comments from the FAA or NHDOT/BA at this time.
- Gale has reached out to the FAA for an update on the status of their review and will report any
  updates in person at this meeting.
- Upon receipt of the preliminary design comments, Gale will continue preparing the 90% Design Submittal.

### Recommended Actions:

None at this time.

#### LAND ACQUISITION

This project is for the acquisition of one privately owned parcel. Project Status:

- The city attorney and seller's attorney have agreed to language for the Purchase and Sale Agreement which Gale understands has been executed by the Airport.
- The parcel was acquired on 9/26/2023.
- Gale will assist the Airport in preparing a grant application for FAA funding for future reimbursement (95%) of the acquisition.

Nik will follow up with Matt Caron to see the status of this grant application.

### Recommended Actions:

Execute the grant application once is completed.

## **TOWER SITING STUDY**

This project will evaluate up to three (3) possible locations for a new Air Traffic Control Tower and make a final recommendation on the preferred location.

#### **Project Status:**

- A Grant Offer has been made to the NAA for this study. Upon approval of the NH Governor & Council, we will begin the Phase I Environmental Site Assessment for this project.
- The overall siting study takes approximately 18 months to complete. The actual study takes approximately 6 months from commencement to completion; however due to a backlog of similar studies at other Airports, the FAA's lead time to starting the project once agreements are signed is approximately 12 months.

 Gale's Contract is still pending for this project. After last month's meeting the draft contract was submitted to the Board for review/approval. If there are no comments/questions, please execute this contract so that we can initiate the Phase 1 ESA.

# **RUNWAY CENTERLINE CRACK SEALING AND RSA REPAIRS**

  estimated scope/fee for comparison.
