Amongst the magnificent tombs of Kings and Queens buried on the West Bank of the Nile are the not so lavish but equally intriguing and important tombs of lesser known people. The Tombs of Maiherpri (KV36) and of Yuya and Tjuya (KV 46) were found almost intact. Their contents tell us much and yet leave so many questions unanswered. Outside of the Valley of the Kings lie the tombs of Nahkt (TT 52) and Kha and Merit (TT 8) each with a different and fascinating story to tell. This talk will discuss the discovery of these tombs, their contents and what they tell us (or don't tell us) of the occupants and their lives.
