The O.T. promotes or restores independence and improves the quality of life primarily for people with severe and persistent mental illness by developing, administering and conducting occupational therapy group programming for the clients of Hamilton Mental Health Outreach and provides Occupational Therapy services as requested using the recovery-model focus.

This role works closely with our multi-disciplinary team of Psychiatrists and Intensive Case Managers who are Registered Nurses, Social Workers and Occupational Therapists in a client-centred model. The position also includes selected additional duties specific to the O.T. profession, has its own office, and will be of interest to O.T.s who enjoy the community setting working Monday to Fridays from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm.

- Previous experience with individuals suffering from severe and persistent mental illness
- Commitment to principles of psychosocial rehabilitation
