\*Reported the Library's collection of National Geographic magazines dating from 1956 is quite extraordinary! There are also very pristine editions of old encyclopedias. We discussed possible ways to share and promote these resources such as "on this day in history..." with info from National Geographic, letting teachers know of this resource for class content, etc. There are also many old editions of magazines - Saturday Evening Post, Life, Look, etc., which we will offer to the Lowell Historical Society.

\*Will work on a flyer/promo with the school for special activity for youngsters hopefully on a Saturday after school is out for the summer.

4. Carol shared a form for library volunteers which we can fill out and give to Nancy. She will let us know when she needs us and train us re: what to do.
