COLLINS STEAMROLLS TO FIRST TOUR WIN

MADISON CONTINUES DREAM SEASON, BAGS TITLE # 3

COLLINS TURNS WATERLOO EVENT INTO A RUNAWAY VICTORY

Joshua Collins rolled into Waterloo in sharp form, with his big hook ball on target from the start. In the end, the 2-handed southpaw garnered his first-ever GISBT championship. And it came in just his 4th tour event. The Fortson, Georgia native – now bowling out of Davenport, Iowa – set a fast pace in qualifying by averaging 232.25 for his 8 games. This sharp shooting enabled him to rack up a big lead in qualifying, as he rolled into the match play finals 186 pins ahead of the field.

Once the finals began, he immediately served notice that this event was securely in his grasp, as he fired an impressive 279 out of the gate, and that boosted his lead to a whopping 259 pins. He rolled well enough the rest of the way to put the event out of reach; his final margin of victory was 268 pins.

Collins served notice at the season-opening August event in Davenport that he was a player to watch on tour, as he finished runner-up in his first career GISBT event. He followed that up with finishes of 11th and 16th at the September and October tour events. This month, he was not to be denied.

The 18 year-old hauled away a \$450 scholarship for his day's work. For his 16 games, he averaged 226.93. Congratulations, Joshua!

PAST CHAMP YAMADA TAKES RUNNER-UP HONORS

Kai Yamada finished runner-up this month. Yamada, one of 4 2-handers in this month's boy's finals field, earned a \$325 scholarship for his impressive performance. He posted the best match play record of all 8 finalists by winning 6 matches and losing just a pair of contests.

The right-hander from Kaneohe, Hawaii was appearing in the 3rd match play finals of his tour career. Yamada was one of 2 past champions among this month's finalists; he earned his first tour title this season at the September event held in Waterloo.

TACORDA NABS 3rd

Andrei Tacorda was this month's 3rd place finisher; he captured a \$250 scholarship for his day's work. The powerful 2-hander from Roseville, California was appearing in his 4th GISBT match play finals, and this represented his best finish on tour, topping the 4th place finish he put forth at this season's September event in Waterloo.

KEYKAL 4th IN TOUR DEBUT

Bryce Keykal was a new face on tour this month, and he made an immediate splash. The Greensboro, North Carolina native finished 4th in his GISBT debut, capturing a \$225 scholarship in the process. Keykal is an impressive right-hander who definitely bears watching in future events.

WELCOME TO 11 NEW TOUR PLAYERS

The GISBT wishes to pay a special welcome to 11 bowlers who made their tour debut at this month's event. Since our tour began in August 1992, more than 2,500 bowlers of the finest young bowlers in the country have competed in Greater Iowa Scholarship Bowling Tour competition. Welcome to each of you, and we hope to see you back on the lanes at our February 13 event in Cedar Rapids!

ERICKSON TAKES 5th

Isaac Erickson continues his fantastic season. The right-hander from Lititz, Pennsylvania has qualified for the match play finals in all 4 of his tour appearances this season. This month, he secured a \$200 scholarship by virtue of his 5th place finish. Earlier this season, he finished 4th at the August event in Davenport, 8th in September in Waterloo, and 3rd at November's tour stop in Muscatine. As a result of these high finishes, he finds himself trailing Zack Denton by just 13 points in the race for 2021-2022 Bowler of the Year with 2 regular-season events remaining on the schedule.

12 YEAR-OLD WEEMS PLACES 6th

Jos Weems added his name to the GISBT record books at this month's event. The highly decorated 12 year-old recorded a 6th place finish, and hauled away a \$175 scholarship for his day's work. The Chicago resident made his tour debut at last season's February event, finishing in 13th place at age 11.

This month – Weems – at age 12 – became just the 4th player at age 12 or younger to qualify for the match play finals. That's right – there have now been 290 events in our tour's history – and this has happened just 4 times!

Ironically, the very first time this happened came 26 years ago – also at Cadillac Lanes – when Joe Roseman earned a runner-up finish at the October 1996 tour event. This occurred during Roseman's tour debut, and it signaled his arrival as a major force in scholarship competition. With 21 tour championships, he remains the boy's all-time tour victory leader, and just 1 behind Katie Maher's all-time tour record of 22 titles.

Weems joins Roseman, Maurice Wynn and Trey Van Wyk as the only bowlers on this list. Trey Van Wyk, who also competed in this month's event, is the youngest boy's match play finalist in tour history when he finished 5th at age 11 in Cedar Rapids at the March 2019 tour stop. A side note – Van Wyk also fired a 300 that day in match play.

LUGO LOGS 7th

Luis Lugo, of Mexico took 7th place at this month's tour stop. The right-handed shotmaker won a \$150 scholarship for his finish. Lugo, a 1-time tour champion, has now appeared in 4 match plays during his career.

EDLER FINISHES 8th IN FIRST CAREER FINALS APPEARANCE

Matthew Edler rounded out this month's boy's finals field. The promising 16 year-old from Cedar Falls, Iowa was making his match play debut; he earned a \$125 scholarship for his performance. The right-hander is in his 2nd season as a tour member, and has continued to display steady progress on the lanes.

TOUR NOTES

JUNIOR GOLD QUALIFYING?

If you are interested In trying to qualify for the 2022 Junior Gold Championship Tournament, held this coming July in Grand Rapids, Michigan, please Facebook message Eric Littig to let him know what age division (U15, U18 or U20) you would try to qualify. If we have enough interested bowlers, we will purchase junior gold spots and conduct qualifying at our February 13 and March 6 events.

13 IN U18 & 8 IN U15 COMPETITORS THIS MONTH

Some of the most promising young bowlers hit the GISBT circuit this month. New this year – the GISBT is paying 1 in 5 for competitors who are under age 15, and 1 in 5 for competitors who are high school bowlers, or ages 15-16-17. This month, we had 13 boy's competitors in the high school or 15-16-17 range, so we paid the top 3 finishers, and 8 boy's younger than 15, so we paid 2 spots in that category. In the girl's division, half of our starting field (10 out of 20) were high school aged or younger, so we paid 2 spots in that division as well.

These talented youngsters represent the very best of youth competition throughout the Midwest. Throughout the 30-year history of the Greater Iowa Scholarship Bowling Tour, many of the nation's brightest young bowlers have graced our stage. Beginning at an early age, bowlers gain experience and knowledge bowling with top level youth, high school and collegiate players. Our tour's stars throughout the years have began their careers at an early age, and advanced to some of the top players in the nation.

We look forward to many of these young bowlers developing into the superstars of tomorrow, and it's awesome to watch them develop their craft in GISBT competition.

REMAINDER OF 2021-2022 SCHEDULE SET

Our tour's remaining schedule has been set for our 2021-2022 30th Anniversary season. Our February 13 event will be hosted by Cedar Rapids Bowling Center in Cedar Rapids. Our March 6 event will be held at Big River Bowling in Davenport, and our Annual Tournament of Champions (top 32 boys and top 16 girls) will be hosted at Hi-Five Lanes in Bettendorf.

Brynna Madison captured her 3rd GISBT championship at this month's event. The slender stroker from Lincoln, Nebraska raked in a \$325 scholarship for her victory.

This title came as a result of her final game heroics, as the position round began with Madison in 3rd place, and the top 4 girls separated by a mere 48 pins. Madison began the position round in 4th place, but reeled off 8 straight strikes to start her final game. The resulting 254 was enough to catapult her into the GISBT Winner's Circle for the 3rd time in her career, with the final margin of victory being just 2 pins.

Madison has enjoyed a breakthrough season in 2021-2022, as she's earned a pair of titles, as well as a pair of runner-up finishes. This doesn't count her August victory at the Tournament of Champions as well. This month, the champion was appearing in her 6th match play finals. She averaged 203.07 for her 14 games. Congratulations, Brynna!

HAMMAN SECURES RUNNER-UP SPOT

Jaelle Hamman was this month's runner-up finisher. The talented right-hander out of Jarrell, Texas, earned a \$225 scholarship for her performance. Hamman made her tour debut at September's event, and finished 4th at that event. This month, she found herself in contention throughout the finals, and despite a 204 position round win that included 3 strikes in the final frame, she was overtaken by the eventual champion's flurry of strikes. Hamman would come up just 2 pins short in her quest for victory.

MCCARTHY TAKES 3rd

Katrina McCarthy continued her fine bowling this season. The southpaw from Pelican Lake, Wisconsin has appeared in 4 tour events this season, and has qualified for the match play finals all 4 times. This month, she finished in 3rd place, raking in a \$200 scholarship.

EVANS PLACES 4th

Gabi Evans turned in another solid finish this month. The tour veteran from West Liberty, Iowa finished in 4th place, earning a \$175 award for her performance. This represented the 10th match play finals of her career.

2-TIME CHAMP URBEN 5th IN TOUR RETURN

Sydney Urben returned to GISBT competition this month, and she would go on to finish in 5th place. The 2-time tour champion from Dorr, Michigan, was appearing in the 5th match play finals of her career. She took home a \$150 scholarship for her performance.

BILLS FINISHES 6th

Marissa Bills rounded out this month's girl's finals field. The talented right-hander from Marion, Iowa reeled in a \$125 scholarship for her finish. This was the 2nd match play finals appearance of her promising career.
