**Tie breaker class is highest placing in western pleasure.

Speed-

Pee wee judged on class #31, 37, 44, 50
Jr. Jr. judged on class #32, 38, 45, 51
Jr. judged on class #33, 39, 46, 52
Sr. judged on class #34, 40, 47, 53
Sr. Sr. judged on class #35, 41, 48, 54
**Tie Breaker class is fastest time in flags.

SHOW RULES

General

- Ages are as of 1st of year.
- Formal attire is expected in Pleasure classes. Collared shirt or Circle K-D apparel is expected for Speed classes.
- All horses on Circle K-D grounds MUST have a current negative coggins or an out of state health certificate. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Safety helmets are required for riders under 18 years of age in all jumping classes. Helmets are always highly recommended in all classes at K-D.
- Boots or riding shoes with heels are required for all riders.
- Show committee has final decision on any changes or disputes.
- Classes may be cancelled or combined at chairperson(s) discretion.
- Circle K-D or its members are not responsible for any accidents, injuries or loss of property. You ride at your own risk!
- A qualified Circle K-D person will judge and manage timed events.
- No stallions allowed on grounds.
- All Circle K-D rules will be enforced and must be followed at all times. Rules and regulations can be viewed at www.circlekd.com and will be available on the grounds the day of the show.
- This show was designed to be fun, reasonably priced and to teach or school either horse or rider for showing.
- While riding at Circle K-D, photos may be taken which will then be used on our website, Facebook or other publicity efforts to promote our club.

Lead Line

- Judging will be based on the rider's ability to control and steer the horses themselves.
- The lead person must be at least 16 years of age and is there for safety in case a horse gets out of control.

Registration

- An entry form must be completed for each horse/rider combination. ALL information provided must be ACCURATE and LEGIBLE. A parent or guardian must accompany and sign for a minor.
- Riders will not be added to a class until the fees are paid.

Class Fees

- If you're not sure what to pay because you may be riding all day, a deposit is required in the form of an open check made out to Circle K-D. At the end of the day your classes are totaled and the check is finalized. Please note that there are no refunds for scratched classes!
- Please note that last minute changes may not be honored.
- No refunds.

Show Series

- There are 3 classes chosen from each of the 6 show bills, which will count for points towards the year-end highpoints.
- There are some speed, pleasure, and fun classes chosen so that we calculate the best all-around horses.
- Rider must compete in a minimum of 4 shows in order to be eligible. It does not matter which of the 6 shows you choose from.
- At the end of the season, there will be a Peewee, Junior Junior, Junior, Senior, and Senior Senior highpoint calculated from all 6 shows. Winners of the age division will receive a belt buckle as their prize.
- Buckles will be presented to the winners in November after the season is over.
