

Luke 1:39-56


### Owensboro Area and St. Pius X Catholic Young Adult Co-ed/Pick-up Softball

Classes will meet every Thursday night from September 9th until Lent begins. A more detailed scheduled will come out shortly, but you'll learn the most by joining us on September 9th!


