Millie was a member of French River Lutheran Church, the Homesteaders, and the Angel Group. She enjoyed reading.

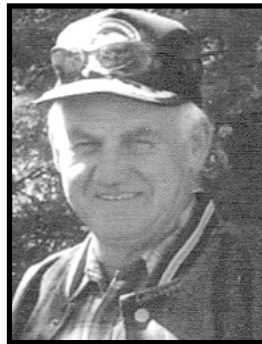
Millie was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Don; and a brother, Warren "Bub" Pete" Peters.
