

Rick is married to the former Stacy Hadley of Buhler, they have one daughter Alyssa age 16. Congratulations to all!



Hutch Updates:



Reno permits on rise: Horizontal drilling for oil and gas exploration in Reno County is picking up, state records show. The level of activity here, however, remains nowhere near that of a couple of neighboring counties to the south.

Statewide, the total number of notices of intent grew by nearly 2,300 over last year. The total 6,901 notices filed from Jan. 1 through Oct. 31 included 252 intended horizontal wells, compared to just 42 horizontal wells all of last year.

Negotiations on Hutch movie theater's lease continue; deadline is set

Negotiations on the lease for the Mall 8 Theatre in Hutchinson continue and a new deadline for approving or rejecting an agreement has been set for the end of the year, according to an attorney in the case.

"They are actively negotiating," Stolte said of Rubloff. Hutchinson was originally one of four theaters around the country included in a motion to allow Dickinson Theatres to abandon the leases as "a drain on cash flow." 
*Hail to the Hall: 100 Years of Convention Hall
