

CONSTRUCTION AHEAD

TRAFFIC SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS COMING TO YOUR AREA

Over the past year, City of Bellevue Transportation staff have heard from the neighborhood residents in and around the Newport Way Library and South Bellevue Community Center expressing a desire to improve safety for pedestrians. As an outcome of that community involvement, the city has included a new sidewalk project along Newport Way in its recently adopted budget.

In order to more quickly improve traffic safety, the Transportation Department will be installing radar feedback signs in two locations on Newport Way near the South Bellevue Community Center (see map on back). These signs, which display a vehicle's speed on a reader board, have been effective at decreasing speeds by encouraging motorists to obey the posted speed limit.

To better reflect the character of the neighborhood, the City also will be lowering the speed limit to 30 mph between Somerset Blvd and 142nd Pl SE and to 25 mph between the library and the community center. All of the new signing is anticipated to be installed by the end of December.
