



Minutes May 6, 2015

The GSSN met on Wednesday, May 6, 2015 at the American Legion Hall in Henderson NV. President John Anderson called me meeting to order at 6:30 PM & led in pledging allegiance to the flag. He welcomed all and introduced officers. (51 people signed in & there were 6 visitors.) John A. asked for a motion to approve the previous month's minutes as published in the HighGrader & Tom Douglas made such a motion which was seconded by Pam Goulder. All were in favor and the motion was approved. Then Mark Hedges gave the treasurer's report. Merwick Black made a motion to approve the report as given, & Morris Seguin seconded the motion. Again, all were in favor and the motion was approved. At this time John A. reported that we got 18 new members in April, with 20 renewals, totalling 423 members. (The Gold Show gave us a lot of exposure.) The audit committee reported it had met and conducted a successful audit on April 23, 2015. Hank Householter made a motion to accept audit report, which was seconded by Pam Goulder. As previously, all were in favor and the motion carried.

Next on the agenda was the 40-acre parcel in AZ (at Gold Basin). President John Anderson said we now have a realtor representing GSSN, having set up a \$500 escrow a/c, with \$500 required deposit -- we will be kept up to date as the matter progresses. Next, donations were brought up. Pam G. made a motion to donate \$750 to McCaw School of Mines, which was seconded by Morris S. Motion was approved & the motion carried. Then Pam G. made a motion to donate \$100 to PLP (which we usually do annually), & Morris seconded the motion, which was approved & the motion carried.

The meeting was then turned over to Mike Ameling, chairman of the Committee reviewing and updating the bylaws. He reported extensively on revisions which were discussed at length by members. He will provide updated revisions for review by membership after he and his fellow committee members (Kathy Martin, David Axtel & George Niederriter) finalize their draft. (Check newsletter for detailed suggested revisions.)

Next outing will be May 16 & 17 (a chili cook-off) again check newsletter for info - but anyone wanting to attend should RSVP as usual. Those helping out at April's outing were thanked for their efforts. After a short break the raffles were held (see below) and at 9PM Pam made a motion to adjourn the meeting, which was seconded by Tom Douglas & the meeting ended at that time.
