Awards: 6 ribbons per class. Plus Special Awards

Championships – If you have ridden in at least 2 of the 2018 Dressage Experience shows you are qualified for Championships. You will enter the show as normal and Championship placings will be determined based on the combined average of the 2 qualifying tests ridden that day.

Bareback Dressage Challenge Test of Choice – Just as it sounds, you choose the test to ride without a saddle.

All riders, youth and adult, must wear a properly fitting equestrian helmet, passing or surpassing current applicable ASTM/SEI (American Society for Testing and Materials/Safety Equipment Institute) standards, with chin strap secured, while mounted at any time/anywhere on the competition/event grounds.
