

# Invite Your Family and Friends



Just as the annual celebration of Resurrection Sunday often makes people more inclined to attend a church service in their vicinity, the concerns about the effects and spread of the coronavirus may make many people more responsive to invitations to *stay home* and yet *tune in* to live-feed broadcasts of Resurrection Sunday services. This is an excellent opportunity for you to invite members of your own family, extended family, neighbors, friends and acquaintances (both local and non-local) to join you in worshipping together this weekend! You can even ask out-of-state and out-of-country loved ones to participate in PCC's Good Friday and Resurrection Sunday celebrations!

If you would like some suggestions on how to handle such invitations, the following will provide you with the text for copying and pasting into an email that you can send to everyone on your list, or edit it as you see fit.

You will want to start with your own personal greetings and text appropriate for those to whom you are writing. Somewhere after that, you could say:

*Like everyone else this year, because of the coronavirus restrictions I won't be attending a large gathering on the campus where my church usually meets. However, I am very thankful that the leadership of my church is providing live-streaming of two Resurrection Sunday services on April 12! I plan to tune in for both services. Would you be willing to "join" me that day?*

*If you don't have a Facebook account you can watch the services on **YouTube**. Go to [bit.ly/YouTubePCC](https://bit.ly/YouTubePCC) to watch the **Sunrise Service broadcast at 6:00AM**, and the **Resurrection Sunday broadcast at 9:15AM**.*

*Also, at those same web locations, PCC will be streaming our **Good Friday service at 7:00** on the evening of **April 10**.*

You could conclude your email with your own comments. Maybe something like this:

*I always look forward to these special Resurrection Sunday services. I know that Jesus died for my sin, that He was buried then raised to life three days later. I know that He has saved me because I trust in Him! It would mean so much to me if you would join me in worshipping Him this weekend! Please let me know.*

We pray that this will be used by the Lord to draw people to Himself in faith.
