Board Minutes as of January 12th, 2010!

The GSSN Executive Board met at Saxby's Coffee House on Tuesday, Jan. 12th, 2010 at 6:35PM. Attending were Carl Richwine, Joyce Johnson, Dara Thaler, Ian Thaler, Fred Zajac, Bonnie Evelyn, Marcia Richwine, John Roberts, Nicolas Johnson and Dolores Gee. Richard Walton attended but did not participate. Carl explained the functions of board members and committee chairpersons in regard to making motions, etc. He gave an overview for 2010 (Including membership, taxes and tax -exempt status, and the IRS). He then brought up future board meetings in regard to when and where. After a brief discussion Fred Zajac made a motion to hold such meetings at Dara Thaler's where previous meetings had been held in 2009. Ian Thaler seconded the motion. Discussion was followed by a vote which was unanimously in favor of the motion, and it was approved.

Carl then went over the budget focusing on certain expenses and income as listed on the attached spread sheet. Using a CPA was discussed, and this possibility will be explored further before any decision is made. New claim books, insurance and finances were discussed. Carl made a motion to set aside \$3,000 as a contingency (or "rainy day") fund and Dara Seconded the motion. There was a brief discussion about the liquidity of our funds, after which Carl amended his motion to be tabled and Joyce Johnson seconded the amending motion. The vote was unanimously in favor of tabling a decision regarding the contingency fund. Next, Fred made a motion to hold two weekend outings each year (one in Spring and one in Fall). Joyce Johnson seconded the motion. There was no discussion and the vote was unanimously in favor. Next, we discussed our claims and whether we might set a goal for 2010 to possibly add one or two claims to our holdings. It was decided to ask the membership for their thoughts on this possibility.

Carl then made a motion for the Merchandise Committee to make up a presentation for the February 4th, meeting relative to pre-selling T-shirts. Joyce Johnson, Merchandise Committee Chairperson, received a \$20 donation from a unanimous donor to secure samples for the presentation and Ian Thaler seconded the motion. After further discussion about pricing, quantities, etc., the vote was unanimously in favor of the motion and it was approved. At 8:10PM Joyce Johnson made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Bonnie Evelyn seconded the motion at which time we vacated the Saxby meeting room.

Dolores Gee motion was a Secretary of the Gold Searchers of agenda item Southern Nevada, Inc. two months.

Carl said he'd been in contact with Nancy DeFalco of the GPAA who gave us a booth for the Gold Show (4/16-18/2010) and there will be a sign up sheet at the next meeting for those wishing to participate (including setup 4/15/10). Reports were given by the following committee chairs: John Bronstein (Claims) said he and his cocommittee members (Al Kraus and Dennis Johnson) were actively involved in their work. Morris Seguin (Outings) said the next outing will be 2-20-2010 at White Hills (#28) claim with lunch being served at 11:30 AM. A straw poll was taken to see who was interested in as 3-day outing in May (14-16) possibly with contests and a "push" and after some discussion Cooter made a motion to table this agenda item for now, and Fred seconded the motion. After a brief discussion, the vote was unanimously in favor of tabling the item. Joyce Johnson (Merchandise) gave a brief report and update and mentioned orders had been taken on samples she'd brought to the meeting and hopefully the t-shirts would be available at the next meeting. I have been looking on the internet about Wind Turbine Generators or WTG's and we keep on getting the same information.

The information that I have collected is about having WTG's installed at the White Hills and White Elephant Wash. Right now the "Bureau of Land Management Kingman Field Office Mohave County Wind Farm Project Environmental Impact Statement (EIS)" They will be out there, checking things out and trying to find out the impact of what these WTG's will have out there. There are a couple of questions on my mind and they are: Can we still prospect on our claims while they are building and operating the Wind Turbine Generator? How will this affect our claims? Will we retain the mineral rights during construction? We have not made any phone calls to the BLM at this time, but will after the next board meeting to open a dialogue and report our findings at the March-3-2010 general meeting.

In the article from the internet it says that they will be doing "Issues and Concerns" They will be checking out: Cultural & Historical resources, Wildlife & their habitats, Sensitive soils, Ground water resources, Air quality, Visual resources, Grazing Activities, Recreational activities & uses, Social & economic conditions in local communities, Mining Claims, & Traffic during construction.
