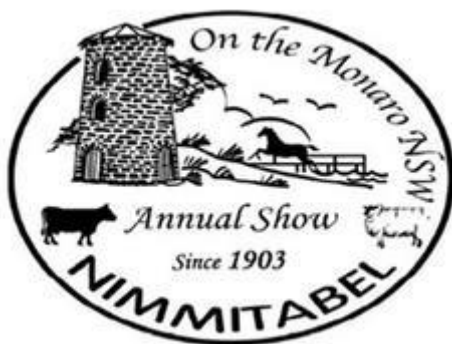

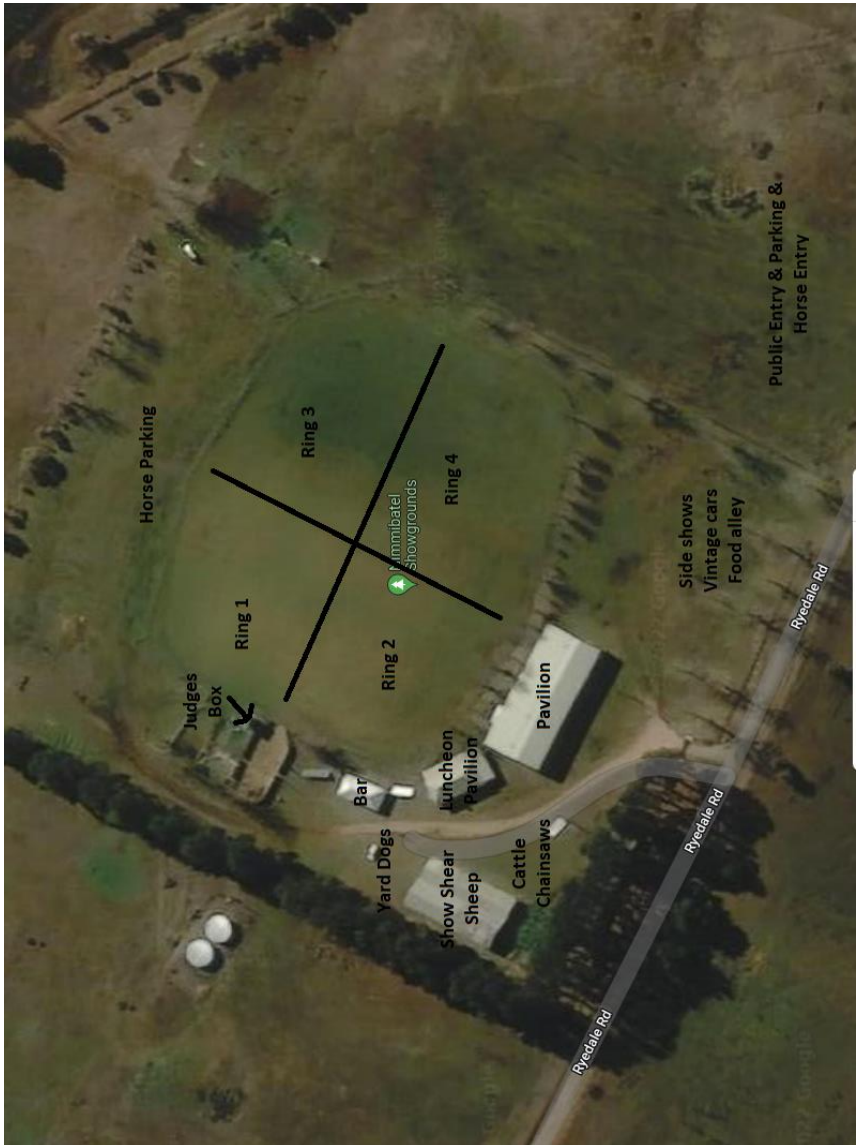

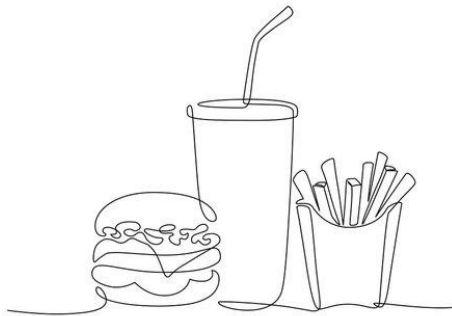
BBQ. Bar & Luncheon Pavilion

THE NIMMITY BELL SHOWJUMPING POINTSCORE

Established in 1981

Please Note: 2023 revised rules made by show committees

Prizes: Rug + 1st = \$450; 2nd = \$240; 3rd = \$160;
4th = \$115 & 5th = \$60

The "Nimmity Bell" show jumping point score is a competition run over 4 shows – Nimmitabel, Delegate, Dalgety and Bombala. The "Nimmity Bell" trophy is to be awarded to the horse & rider combination with the highest point score in open competition over 4 shows. This will be awarded at the completion of events at the Bombala Show jumping events.

1. Horses can only score in **80cm** or higher, novelty events excluded, all entrants in these events will be eligible for the "Nimmity Bell Point score" regardless of the total amount of entries in one class.
2. A horse & rider combination can only score once at each show. This score will be their best placing from that show. If a horse fails to place in an event, it will score zero for that show. The points will be awarded as follows: 1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points, 5th = 1 point, **no placing yet eligible = 0 points. In the case of "tied" placings the points will be spilt, the same way as prizemoney.**
3. **Horses and rider combination must compete at all 4 shows** to be eligible for the "Nimmity Bell Point score". The only exception will be if an official vet / doctor's certificate is presented to the official scorer indicating the horse/ rider's inability to compete at one of the 4 shows.

4. Any disputes regarding the “Nimmit Bell Point score” must be directed to Anita Walder 0428 613 344 to be dealt with. Official protest/s must be made in writing within 1 hour of the class being completed and must be accompanied by \$50.00 and presented to the chief steward of the relevant show.
5. **Please note: It is requested that EA summer dress standards apply for competitors at all four shows** (no polo shirts – shirt with tie or stock to be worn).
6. **Overall prize money will be awarded to the top 5 place getters at the completion of events at Bombala Show.**

Show Regulations

1. Programs in Rings 1, 2, 3 & 4 commence at 8.30am.
2. Approved tagged helmets must be worn in all events.
3. **Any horse misbehaving or not under thorough control may be asked to leave the ring.**
4. **Stallions**: Stallions must have bit in mouth in their respective classes.
5. Stallions must be led or ridden by a person over the age of 18.
6. Stallions are not permitted in hack or riding classes apart from events
7. Stallions must be double tethered.
8. In the event of a competitor having entered classes in different rings, if classes are on at the same time, **NO** disruption to program will be tolerated, except at the Head Steward's discretion.
9. In the event of a horse appearing to be too big or too small it will be at the discretion of the steward or judge to have the horse measured by the Society's Official Measurer.
10. **NO parents, spectators or unauthorised persons allowed in the arena (which includes all 4 ring event areas).**
11. All competitors must enter and leave the ring at a walk; **ANY** person infringing this regulation will be disqualified from the competition.
12. In any flag or bending race, no rider will be permitted to ride more than two horses and must wear an approved helmet.
13. Ribbons will be awarded as stated in the schedule.
14. Participants in Registered classes will need to prove registration if requested.

15. Exhibits which compete in Show Hunter classes are not able to compete in Open or Novice Open Hack classes but may compete in any relevant breed classes.
16. Show Hunters are required to be correctly attired and equipped including plain leather bridle-wear – definitely no ribbon or bling type brow-bands. Hunter riders should be wearing a tweed type jacket and no bling to be sighted.
17. Second chance classes are to be entered by horses that did not place 1st on the day.
18. A fee of \$50.00 may be lodged with disputes in writing 30 minutes after completion of judging. The fee will be forfeited if the committee considers the protest frivolous
19. Show reserves the right to test horse exhibits for prohibitive substances.
20. Judges' decisions are final.

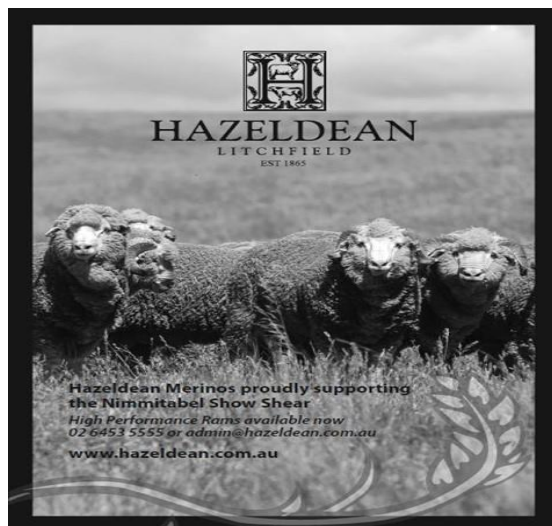
