Meeting was called to order at 5:35 p.m.

- ❖ Orders were approved and signed by the Board unanimously for the Treasurer

Other Business:

- ❖ Truck weight Permits were approved and signed by the Board Chair for the following: **Wind River Environmental, LLC**
- ❖ Christy presented the reappointment papers for the Fire Warden and Deputy Fire Warden from ANR (Agency of Natural Resources). The Board reviewed the paperwork, and all agreed to keep the present position holders in the appointed positions. The Fire Warden is Gerard Nick & the Deputy Fire Warden is Marc Sicotte.
- ❖ Calvin presented the Board with the Bids for the paving of the Town Roads. The Board chair was asked to open and read aloud the bid offers. The prices for the bids per ton are as follows:

FWW- \$72.40/ton estimated 8283 tons

PIKE- \$63.60/ton estimated 7840 tons

GRAYS- \$64.50/ton estimated 7393 tons

J.HUTCHINS INC- \$67.50/ton with rap and \$72.00/ton without rap (virgin) estimated 6300 tons.

S. T. PAVING - \$72.25/ton estimated 6725 tons

After reviewing the Bids, the Board decided to go with the Bid from Gray's paving.

❖ Calvin updated the Board on the problems with Mcallister road. He stated to the Board that he had worked on a Sunday to get the road back in passable condition, and then had to redo it all over again on Tuesday. He is very discouraged with this, for he had spoken with a man who has been hauling big sap tanks up and down the road several times a day. He had asked the man to travel on the road only when the road is frozen early in the morning, and to stay off it when it starts to warm up. The man had mentioned that he would like to fix the road himself when he is done, if he could get gravel from the town. Richard stated that if he wants to pay for the road to be fixed then he can haul the gravel himself. Alden suggested that Calvin get a detailed invoice of the hours spent and the amount of gravel it took to fix the road already and give the bill to the man so that he knows how much it has already cost the town.
