**GoS TEAM needs:** 1 eye doctor with 3 optometry technicians..all fluent in spanish (hopefully Tocoa's Dr. Carlos + 3 selected volunteers..Dra Wasmanski is not sure if she is joining us); 2-4 fitters (fit patient with eye glasses..ask to read chart ..follow fitting instructions..check off patient on list provided when patient is fitted and leaves..we HAVE TO KNOW who receives the eye glasses..we will inventory leftovers as a check..then leave leftovers in hopes patients show up); 1 floating assistant..make sure fitters have chairs and whatever they need...water, etc.....maybe 2 floaters; ...at 3 sites this will be a multi hour event...floaters additional job is to make 100% sure we are keeping track of who receives the eye glasses; 1 person to hand out pastor Harold bibles to recipients..JTD to finalize procedure, equipment and necessary personelle and share with GoS team prior to departure.
