The Salt Lake Deanery held their second meeting of the year at Saint Ann's on October 1. We approved our budget, discussed service projects and planned the upcoming year. We have set the date of March 25 for our annual luncheon at Our Lady of Lourdes Magna and it will be co- hosted with Saint Marguerite.

Our affiliate the Cathedral of the Madeleine Council has had two member brunches (one in September and one in October) at a local restaurant. They had a lovely write-up about CWS and Council in general in their parish bulletin for Council Sunday.

Our Lady of Lourdes Magna Council participated in the Parish's annual Spaghetti dinner and assembled 68 raffle baskets for their fund raiser at this event. They are filling 21 *Box of Joy* to be mailed to Africa. They are donating food to the pantry in Magna for homeless students and hosted a Trunk or Treat.

Saint Ann's Guild is at full speed. They are sponsoring a Giving Tree for the needy families in their parish. They are also requesting masses for members of their parish that have passed and providing a luncheon for their families. The ladies have two retreats coming up: An Advent Retreat in December and a Divine Mercy Retreat in January. They are participating in the Lady of Guadalupe Novena. The Guild will also be making 20 Christmas gift packages for shut-in's of their parish.

Saint Marguerite Council will be focusing more on service and spirituality this year. For Council Sunday they passed out a carnation and a pink rosary bracelet and an invitation that invited ladies to their meeting.

Saint Vincent de Paul is holding coffee & donuts twice a month. They have updated their Bylaws and Standing rules and have filled their commission chairs. The council helped in hosting the farewell for Father Norman and the welcome reception for Father Sam.
