The last month has been busy at the pond. We have an aeration system in place now and a new piece of fishing/bird watching/turtle displaying structure has added itself to the southeast shoreline. That structure being the large pine tree that has leaned over the pond for the last 20+ years. I can say that it is already drawing fish; there were five(5) management bass removed from the east side of the structure one(1) week after it fell in.

Please use your common sense when fishing around the aerators and structure that has not been secured yet. There will be markers attached to the diffusers with rope by the end of the month, please do not pull on them if your lures gets tangled in them. If you feel the need to remove or damage any of these items, remember you are making hundreds of dollars in damage to the club property. I've personally watched more than one(1) member pull the placed structure out of the pond in order to retrieve a lure that was stuck.

We make a maintenance sweep of the pond four(4) times a year, removing tackle, sinkers, floats, line, etc. that are tangled in the trees; if your lure is that important to you, see myself at an open meeting or on the club grounds and I will see that whatever you have left behind is returned to you. If you are forced to cut your line and leave behind a high dollar lure, please contact myself at the number below and I will make arrangements to retrieve it for you in a more timely manner (I understand your pain, but I need you to understand that you are damaging what other members can enjoy).

As a reminder, the pond rules are as follows: (Note '13' is a common number)

- ALL Bluegill and Crappie are catch and release.
- Largemouth bass UNDER 13" are to be removed (no size too small); Largemouth bass OVER 13" are catch and release.
- Children under the age of 13 are the ONLY ones allowed to use redworms/nightcrawlers (NO OTHER LIVE BAIT IS PERMITTED)
- All other anglers are limited to artificial lures only.
- No form of watercraft is allowed on the water
- Access to the pond is limited to the water's edge; no waders, wet wading, or balancing acts on fallen trees.
- The small boat by the pond is for Management use only.
- The pond is available as a dog training area; all members are asked to be respectful of each others space (don't throw your training dummies in the area an angler is in, and don't fish in the area a dog is being trained).
