Amen **First Lesson** Malachi 3:6-12 <u>6</u> "For I am the Lord, I do not change; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob.<u>7</u> Yet from the days of your fathers You have gone away from My ordinances And have not kept them. Return to Me, and I will return to you," Says the Lord of hosts. "But you said, 'In what way shall we return?'<u>8</u> "Will a man rob God? Yet you have robbed Me! But you say, 'In what way have we robbed You?' In tithes and offerings.<u>9</u> You are cursed with a curse, For you have robbed Me, Even this whole nation.<u>10</u> Bring all the tithes into the storehouse, That there may be food in My house, And try Me now in this," Says the Lord of hosts, "If I will not open for you the windows of heaven And pour out for you such blessing That there will not be room enough to receive it.<u>11</u> "And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, So that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, Nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field," Says the Lord of hosts; <u>12</u> "And all nations will call you blessed, For you will be a delightful land," Says the Lord of hosts.

<u>Second Lesson</u> 2 Corinthians 5:18-21 <u>18</u> Now all things are of God, who has reconciled us to Himself through Jesus Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation, <u>19</u> that is, that God was in Christ reconciling the world to Himself, not imputing their trespasses to them, and has committed to us the word of reconciliation. <u>20</u> Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God.<u>21</u> For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for us, that we might become the righteousness of God in Him.

**Gospel John 12:27-36** 27 "Now My soul is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour. 28 Father, glorify Your name." Then a voice came from heaven, saving, "I have both glorified it and will glorify it again."29 Therefore the people who stood by and heard it said that it had thundered. Others said, "An angel has spoken to Him."30 Jesus answered and said, "This voice did not come because of Me, but for your sake.31 Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be cast out.32 And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself."33 This He said, signifying by what death He would die. 34 The people answered Him, "We have heard from the law that the Christ remains forever; and how can You say, 'The Son of Man must be lifted up'? Who is this Son of Man?"35 Then Jesus said to them, "A little while longer the light is with you. Walk while you have the light, lest darkness overtake you; he who walks in darkness does not know where he is going.36 While you have the light, believe in the light, that you may become sons of light." These things Jesus spoke, and departed, and was hidden from them.
