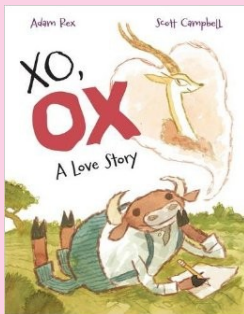


### Doctor Strange

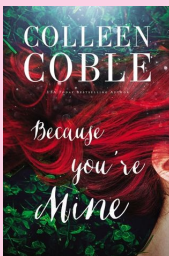

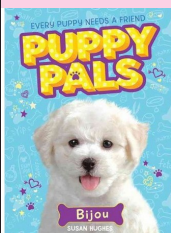
### Because You're Mine

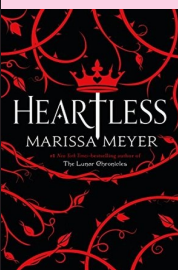


### Crooked Kingdom
